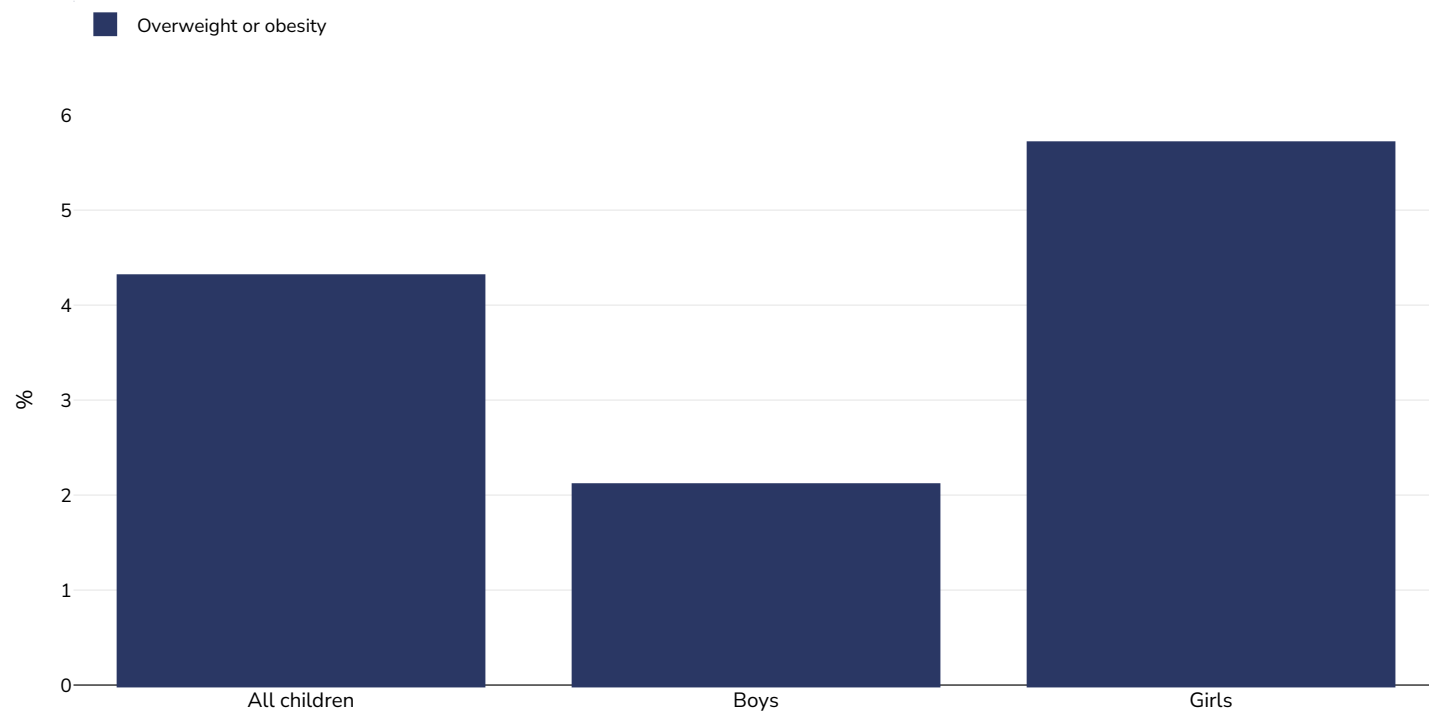

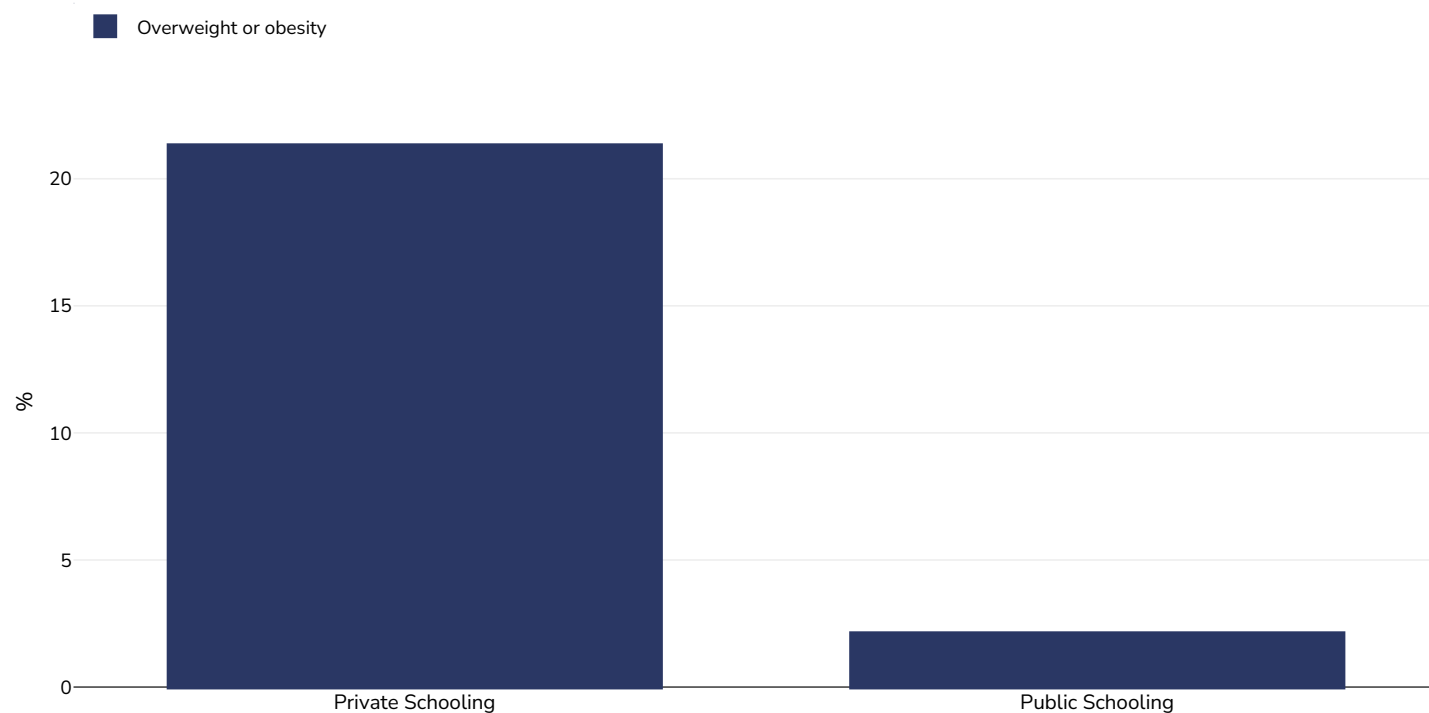

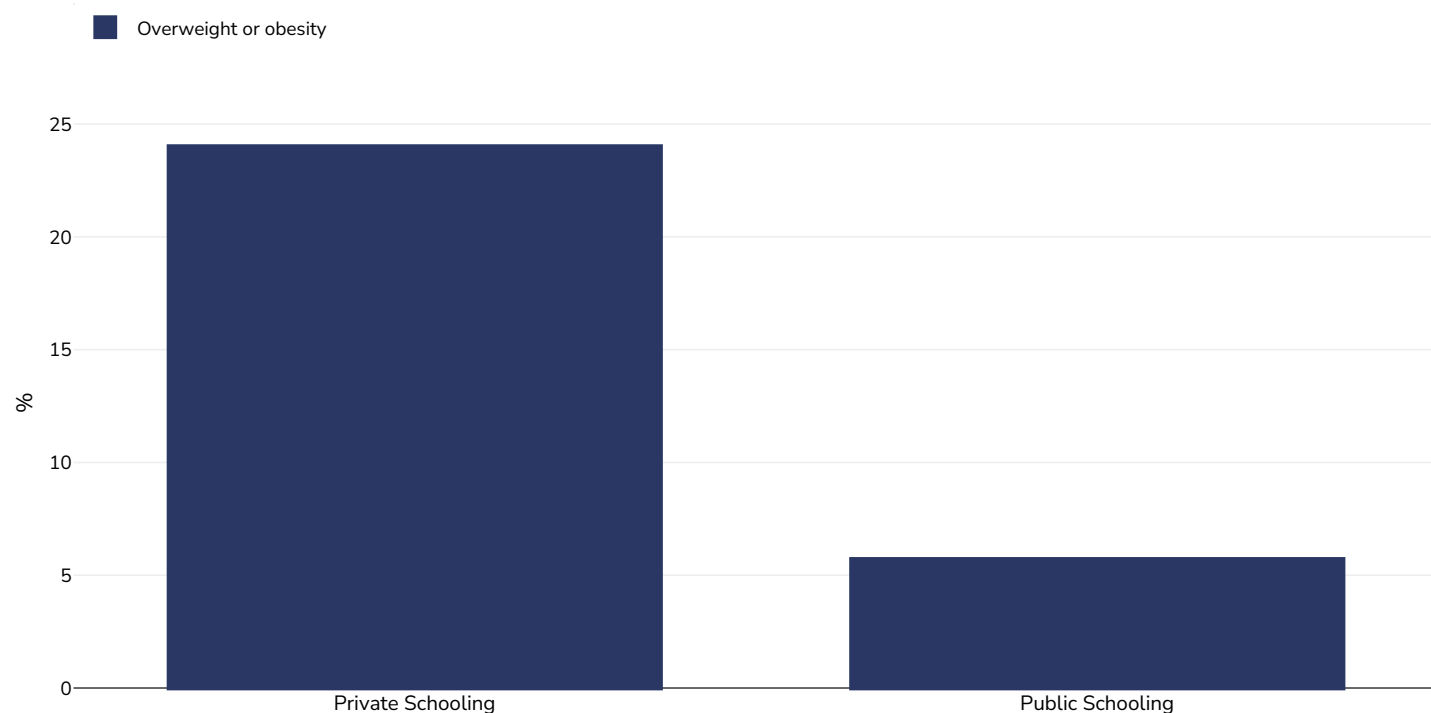

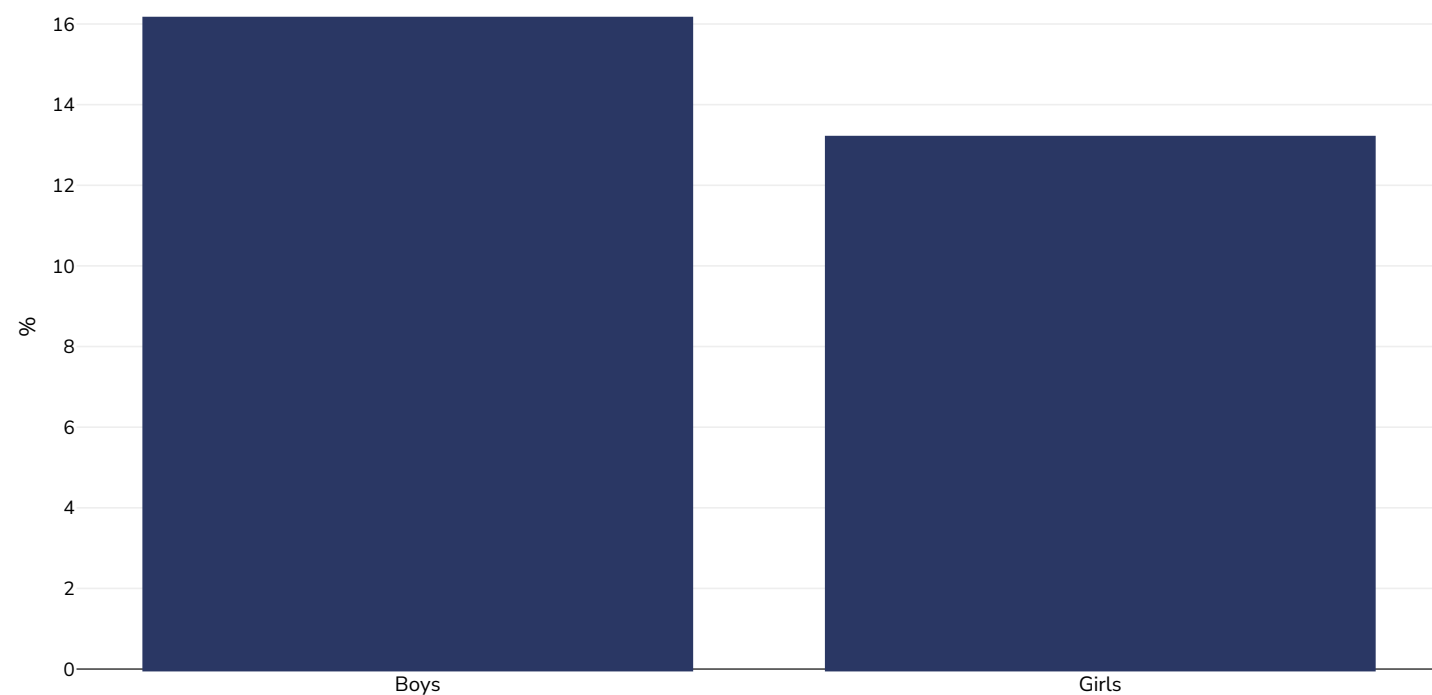

Double burden of underweight & overweight

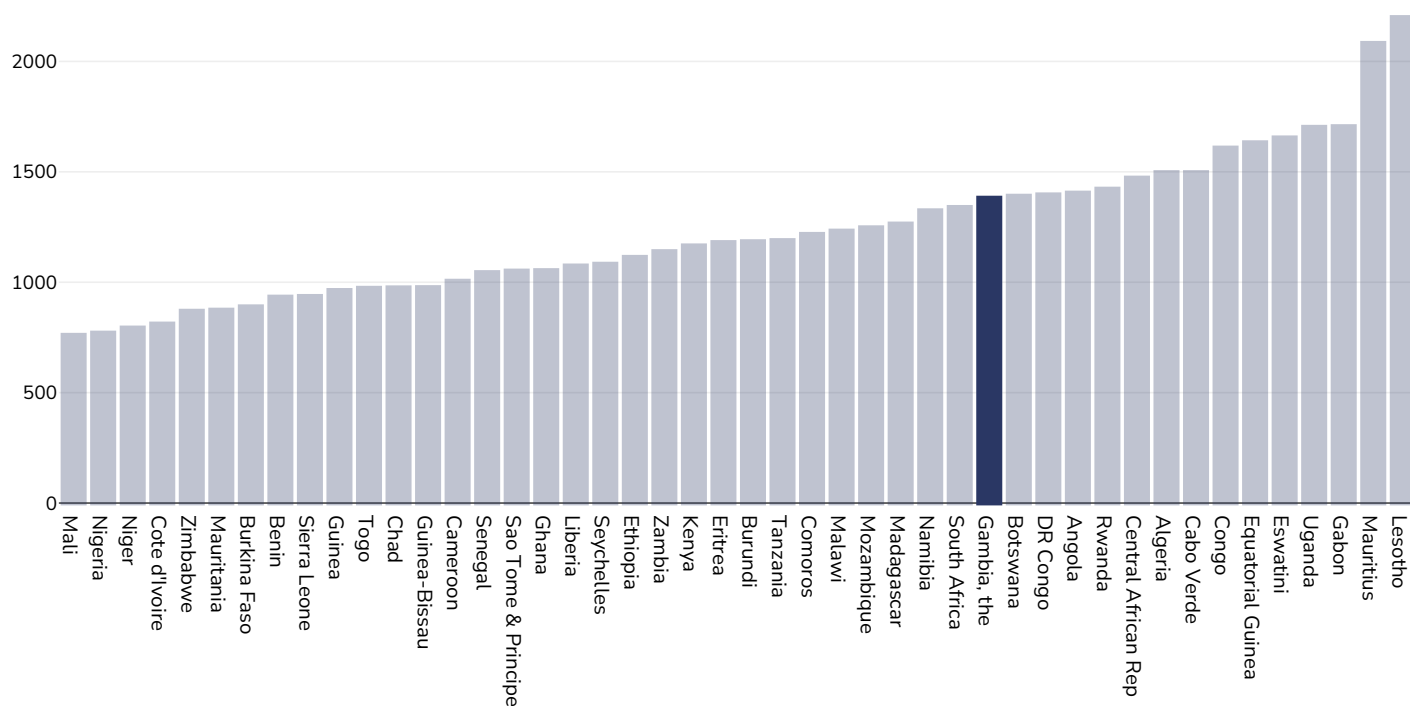

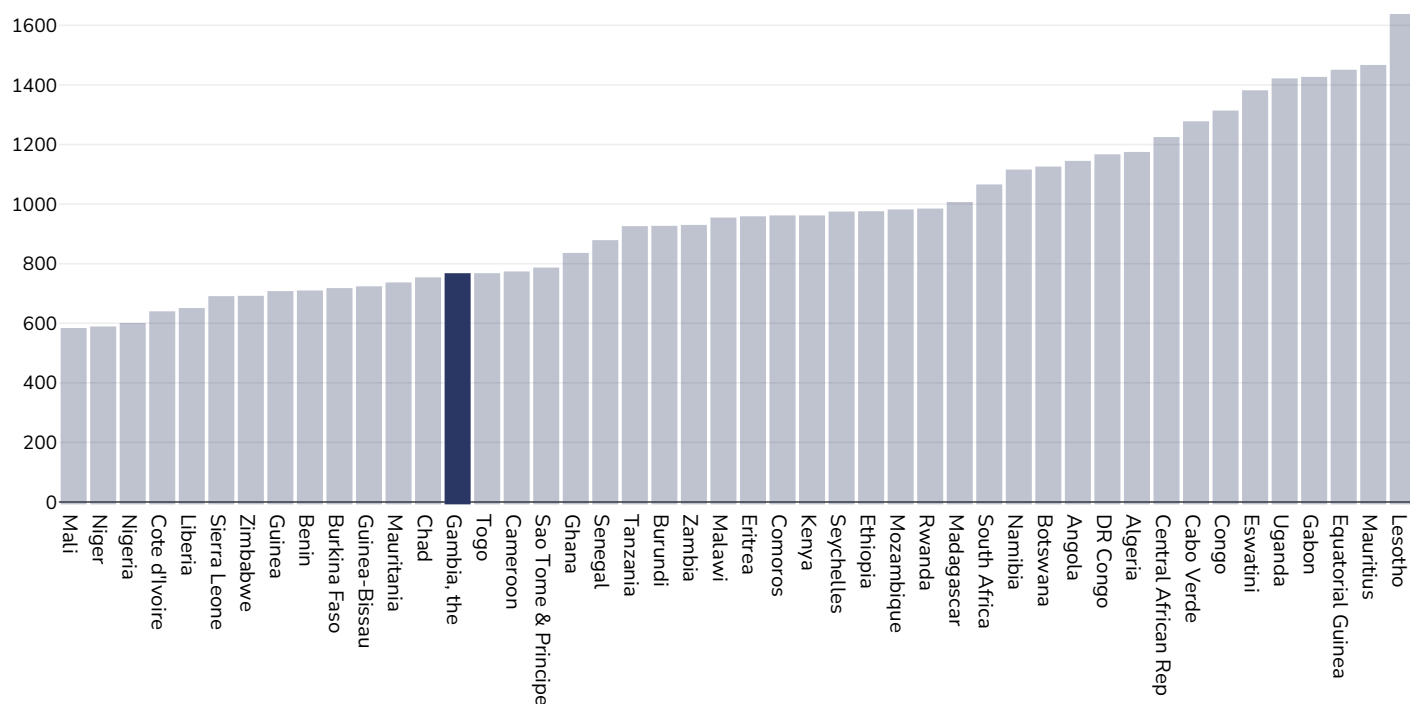
