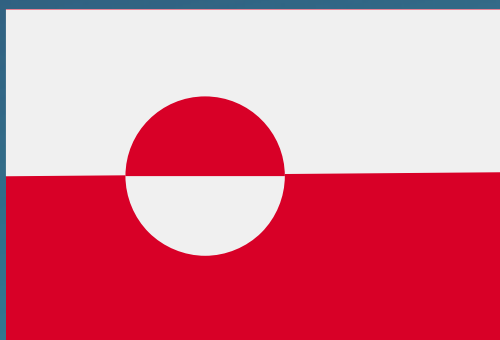

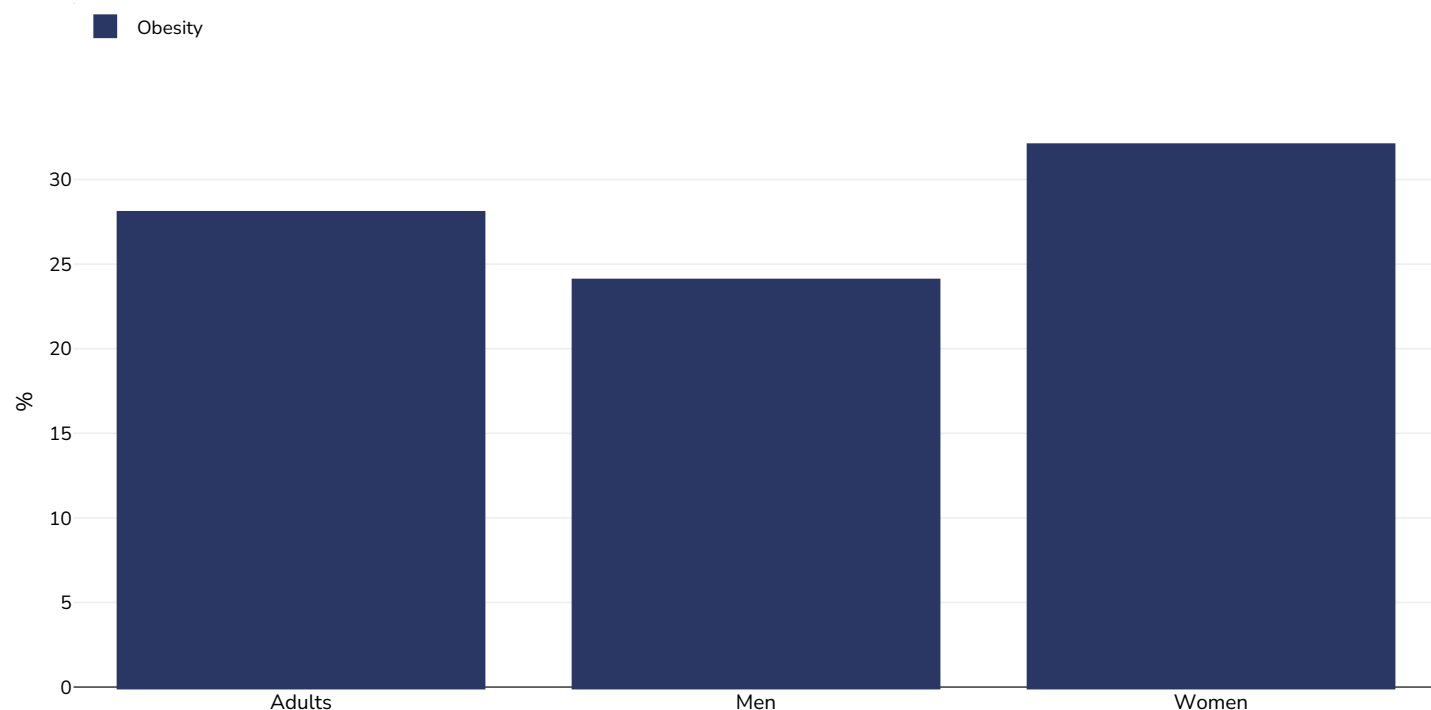

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Obesity prevalence

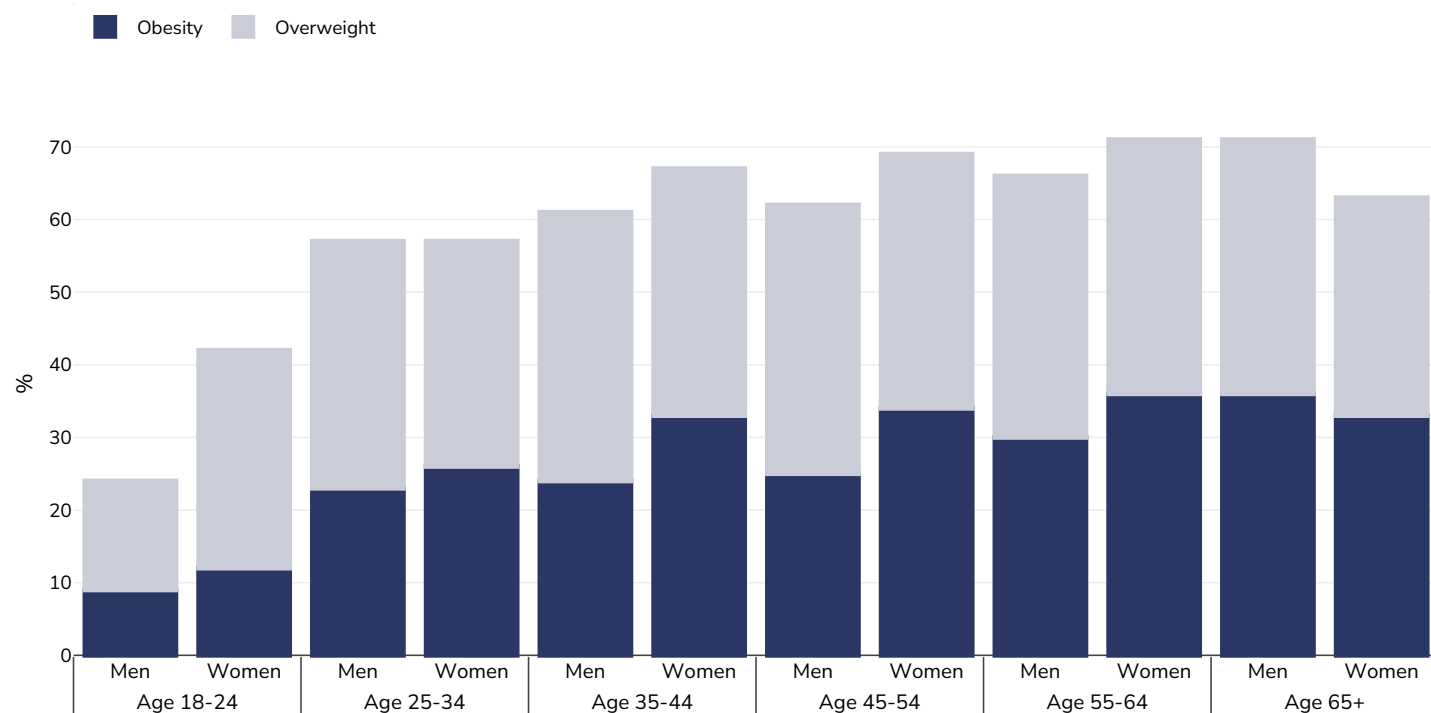

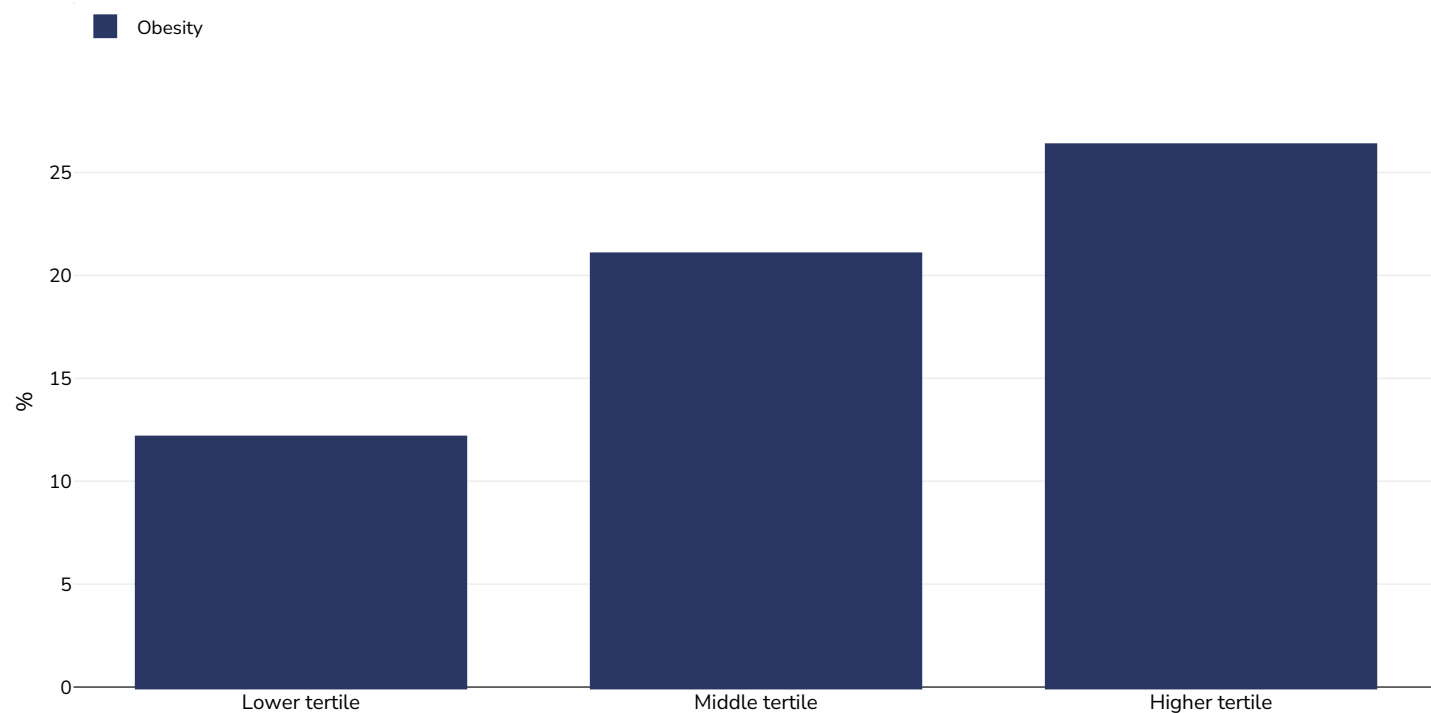

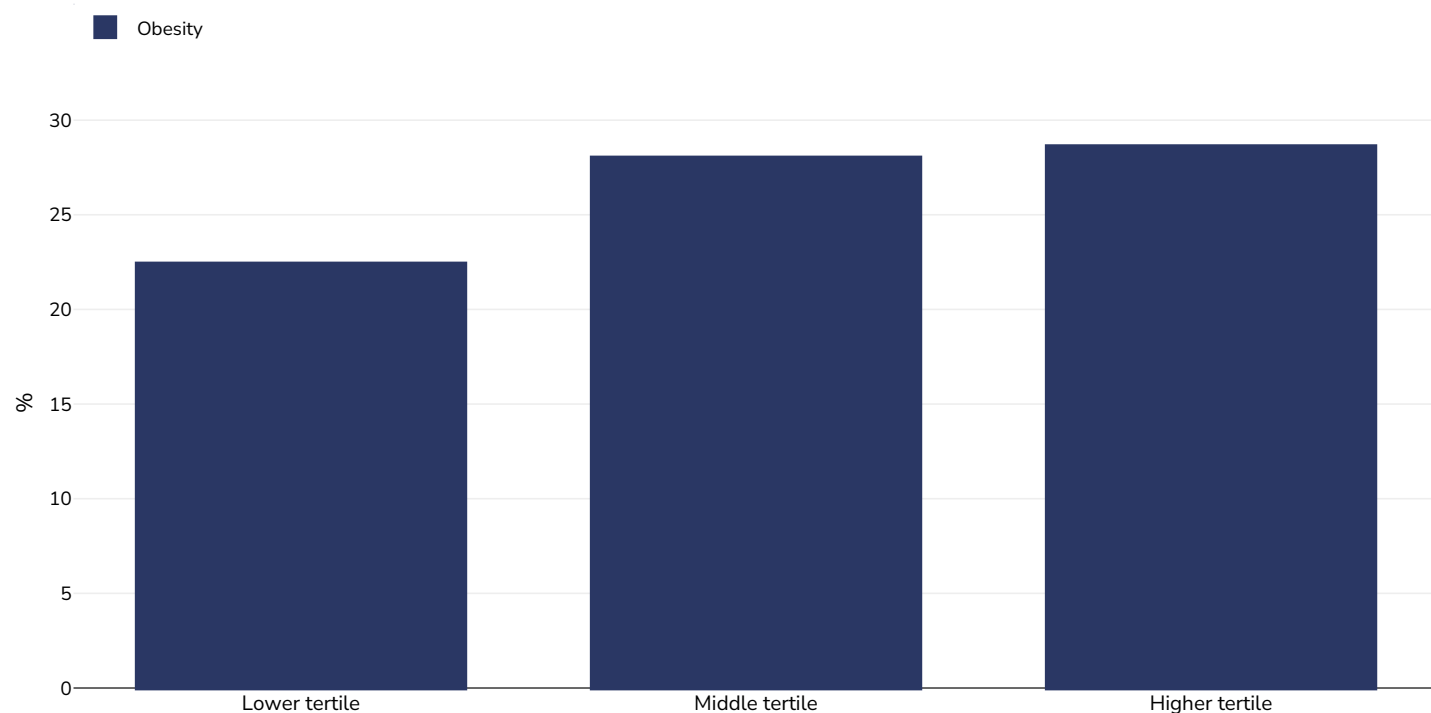
Overweight/obesity by socio-economic group

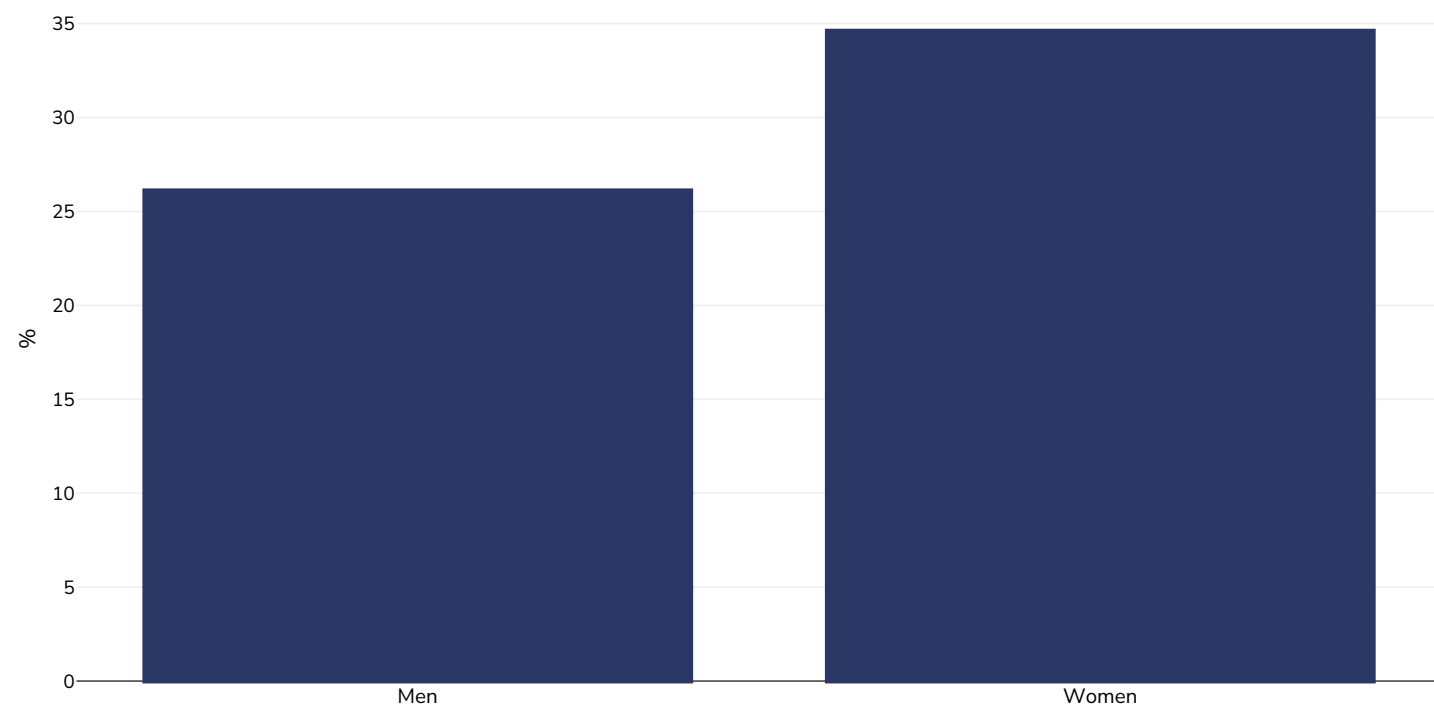

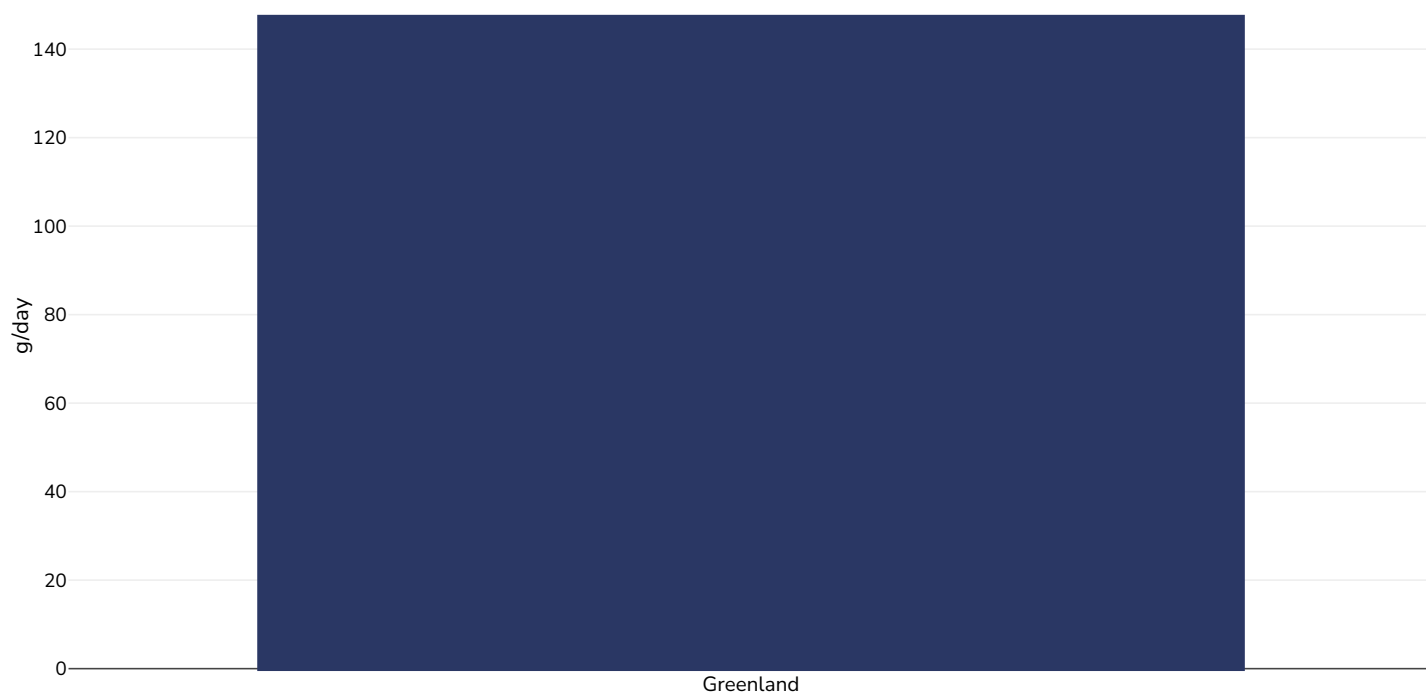

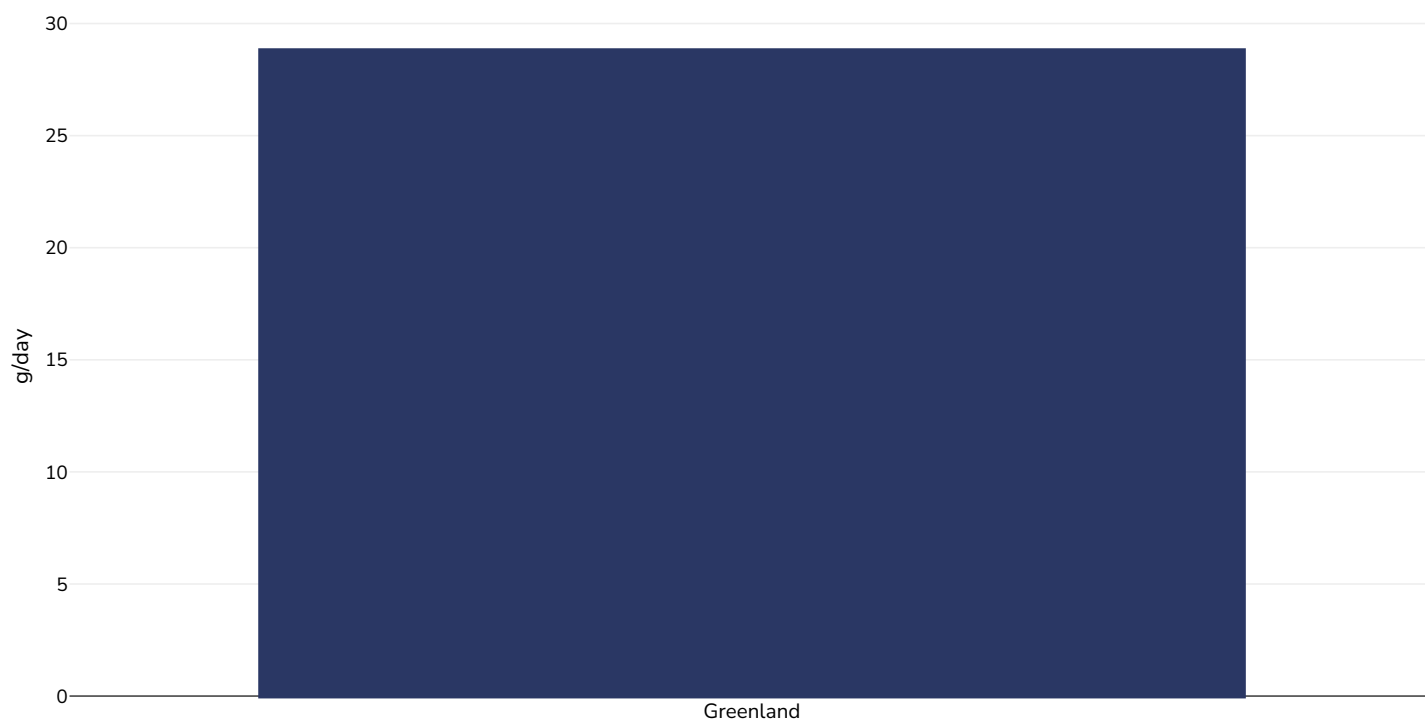

Estimated per capita whole grains intake

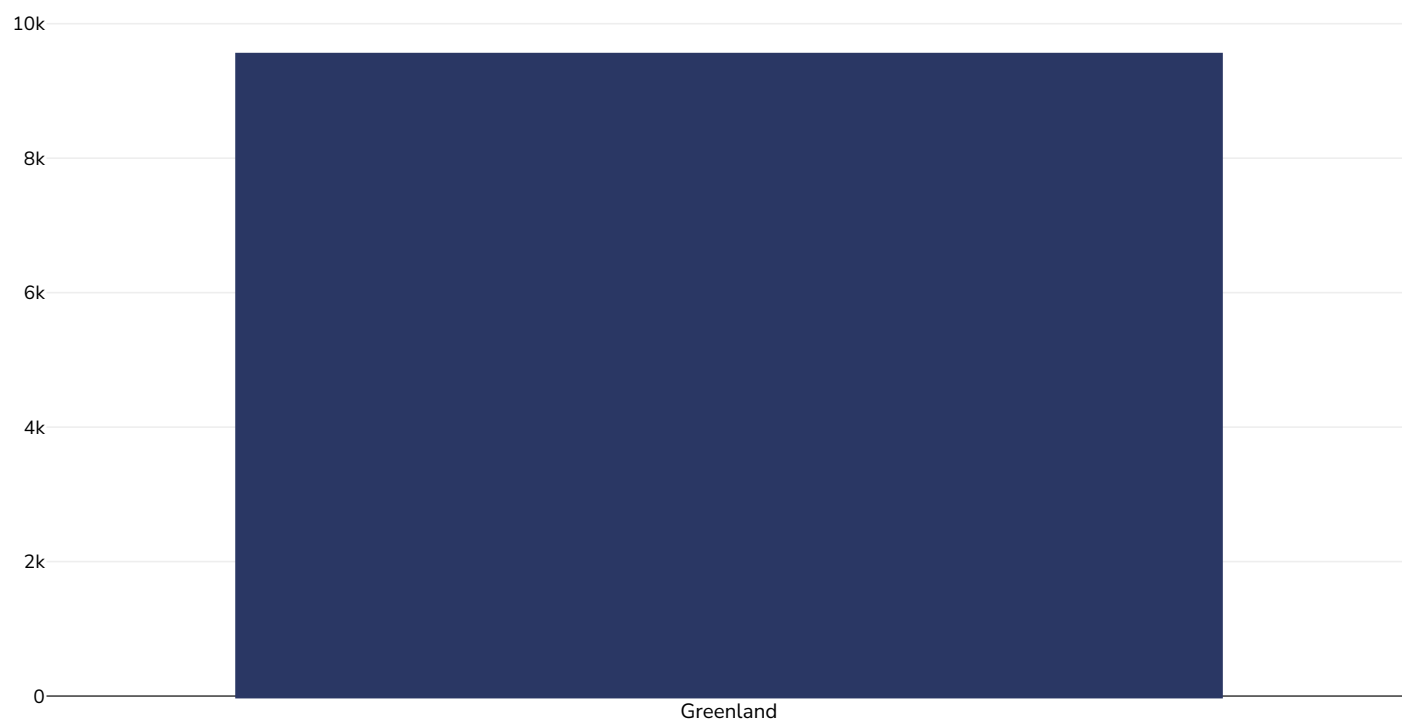

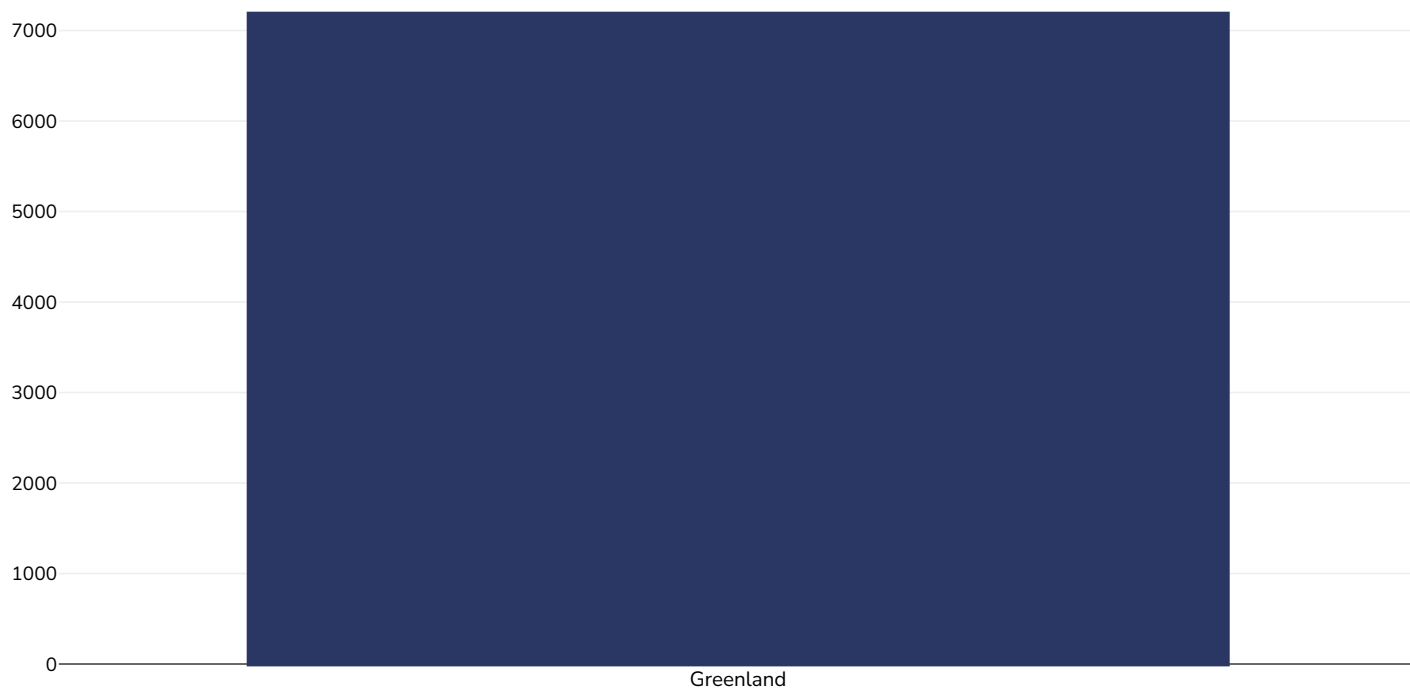

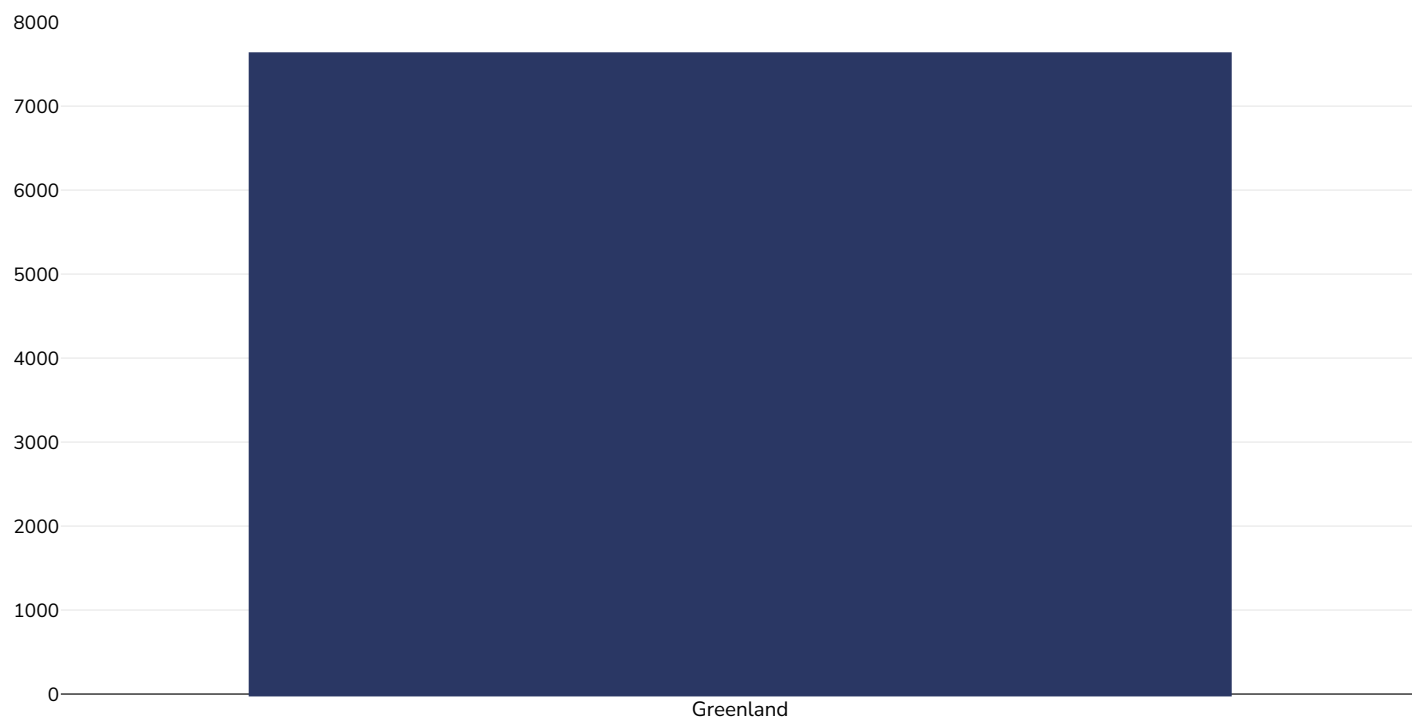

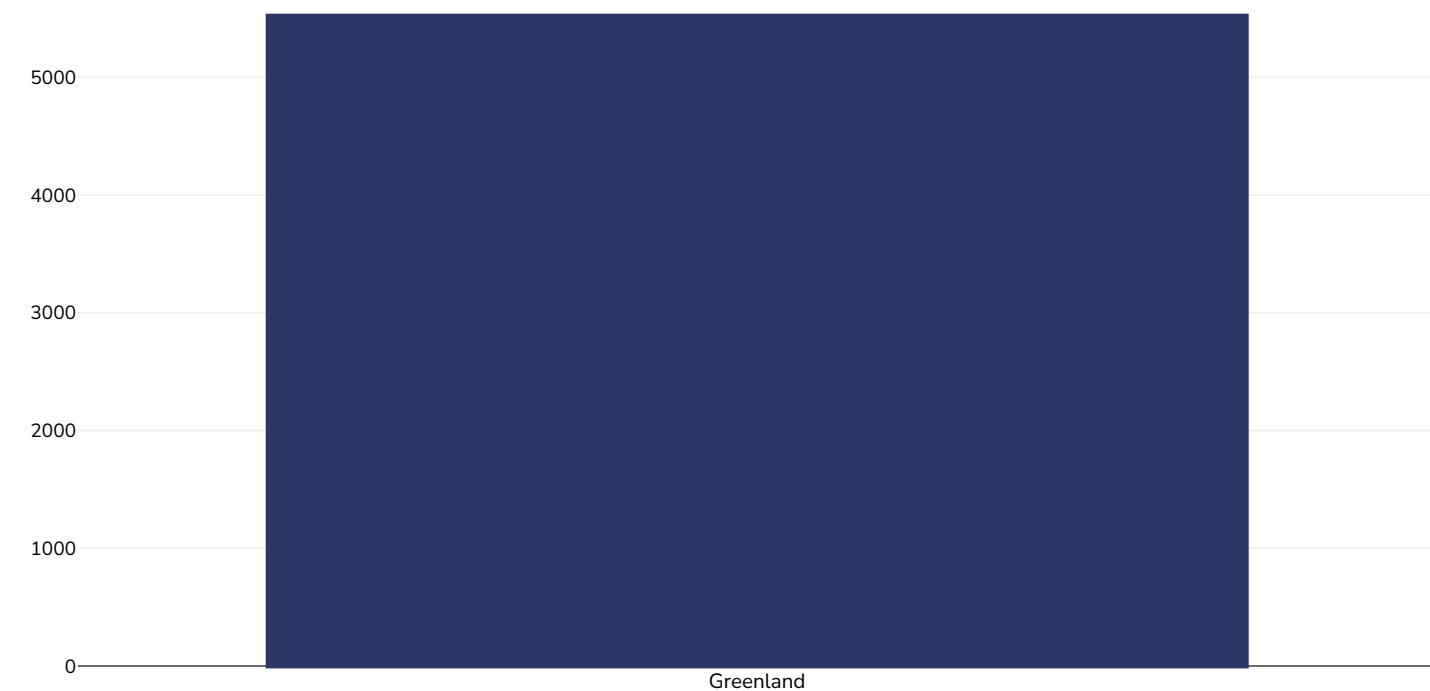

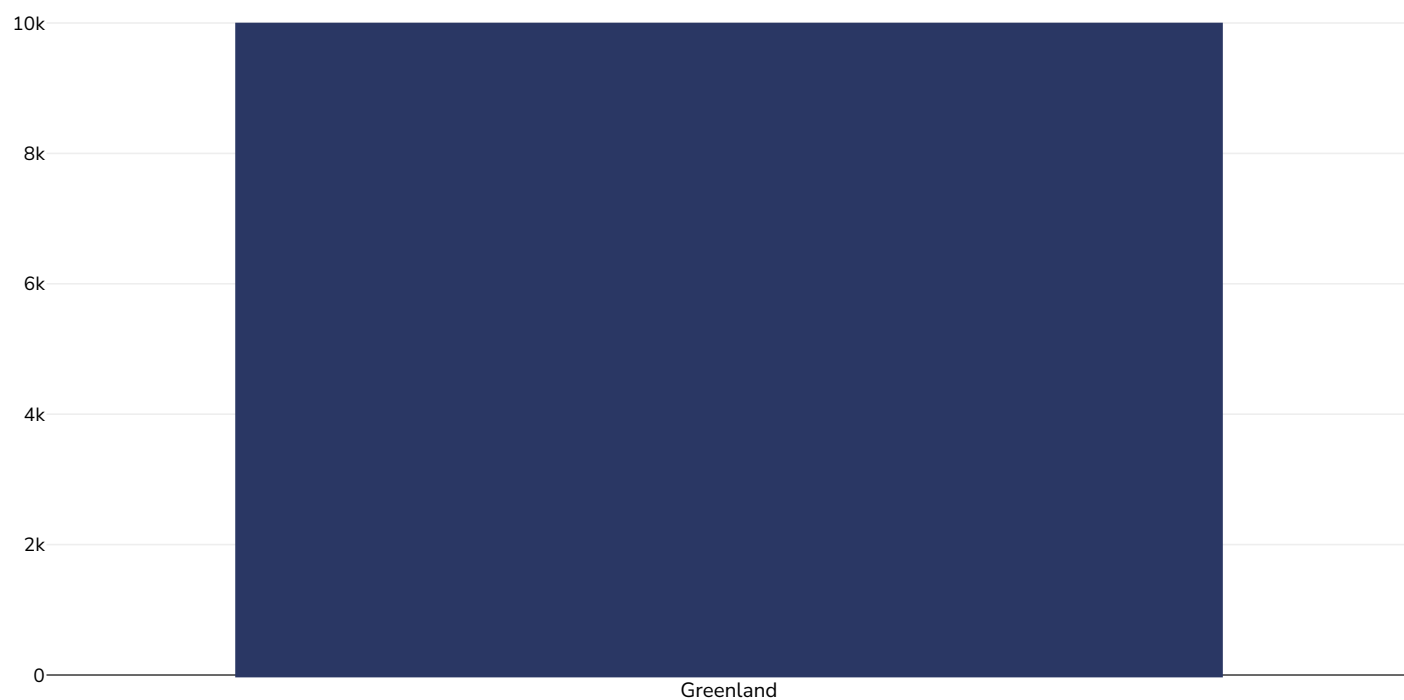

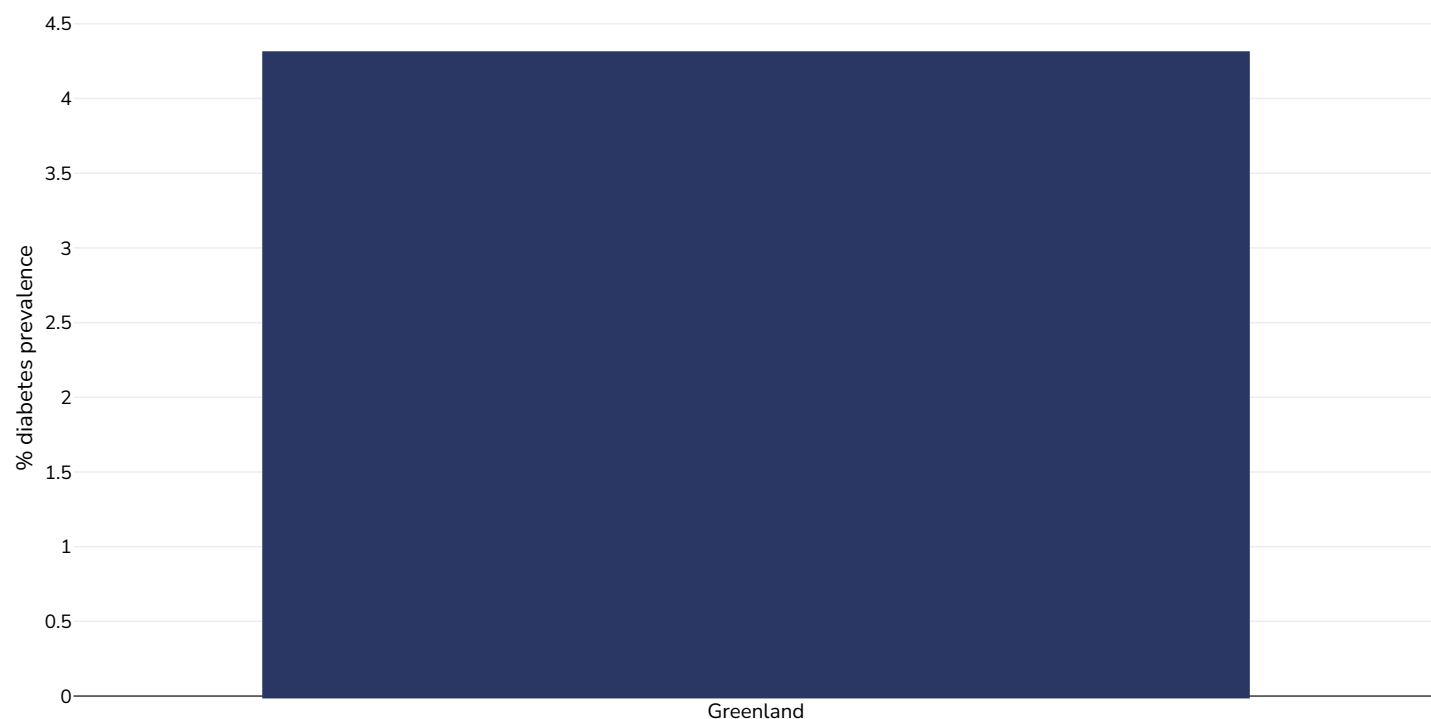
