





















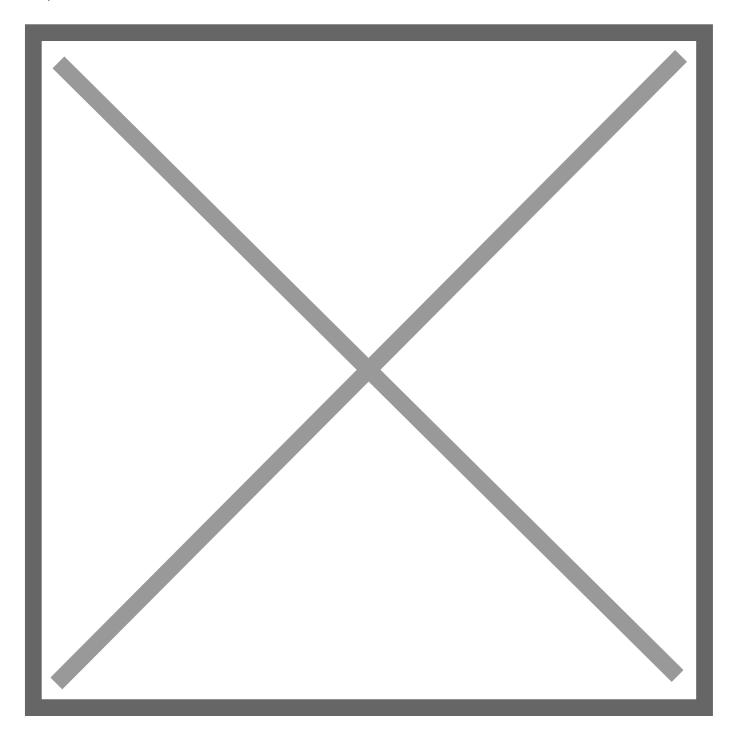




Pancreatic cancer

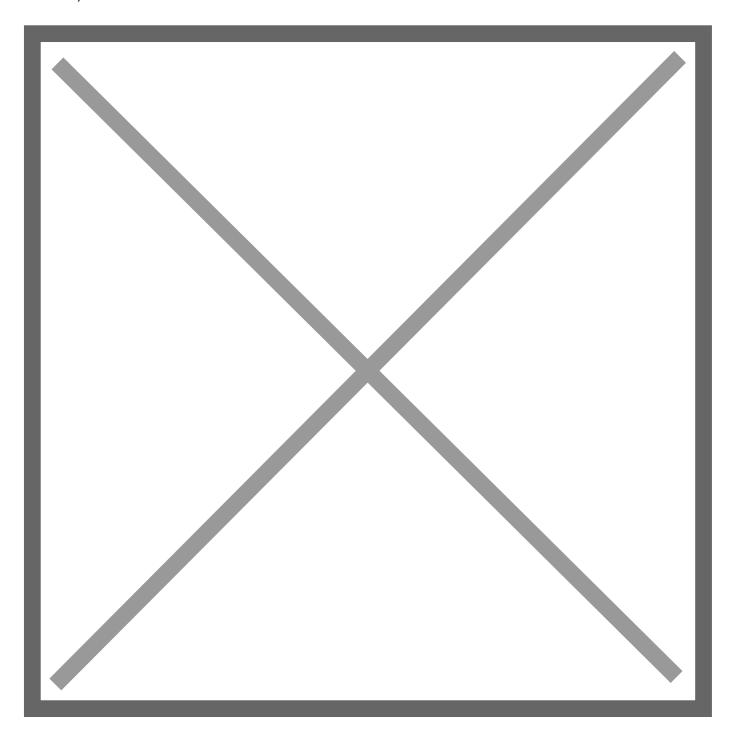




Gallbladder cancer

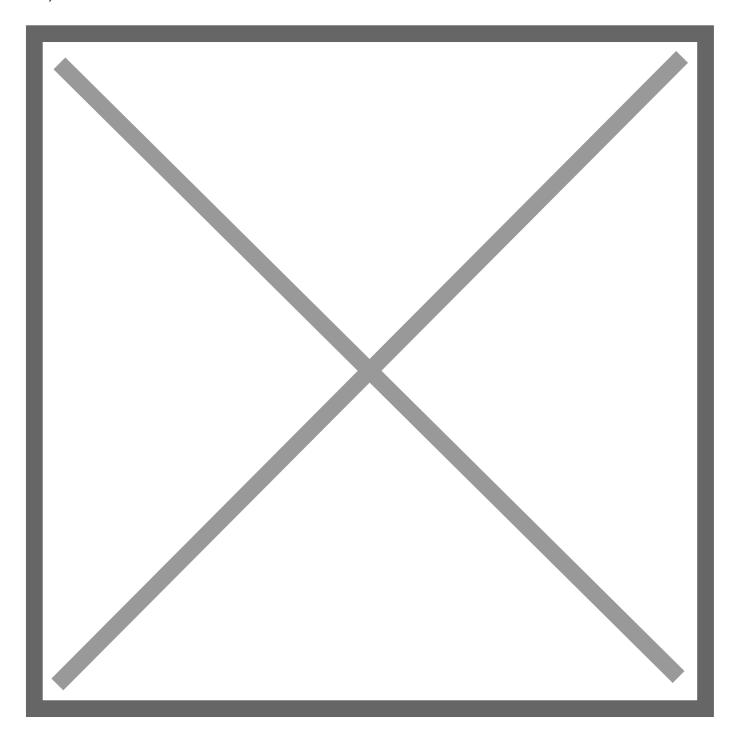




Kidney cancer














