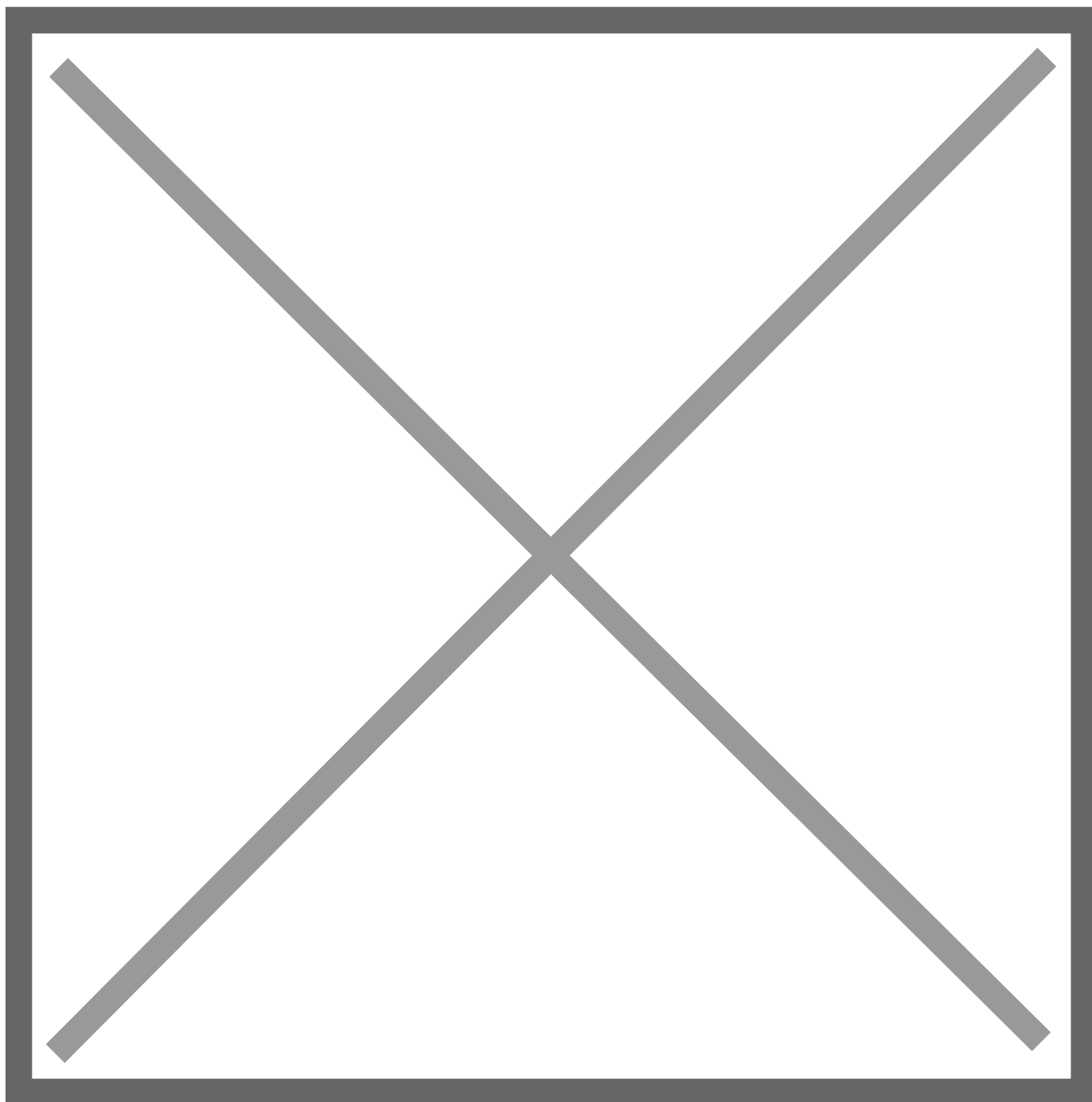

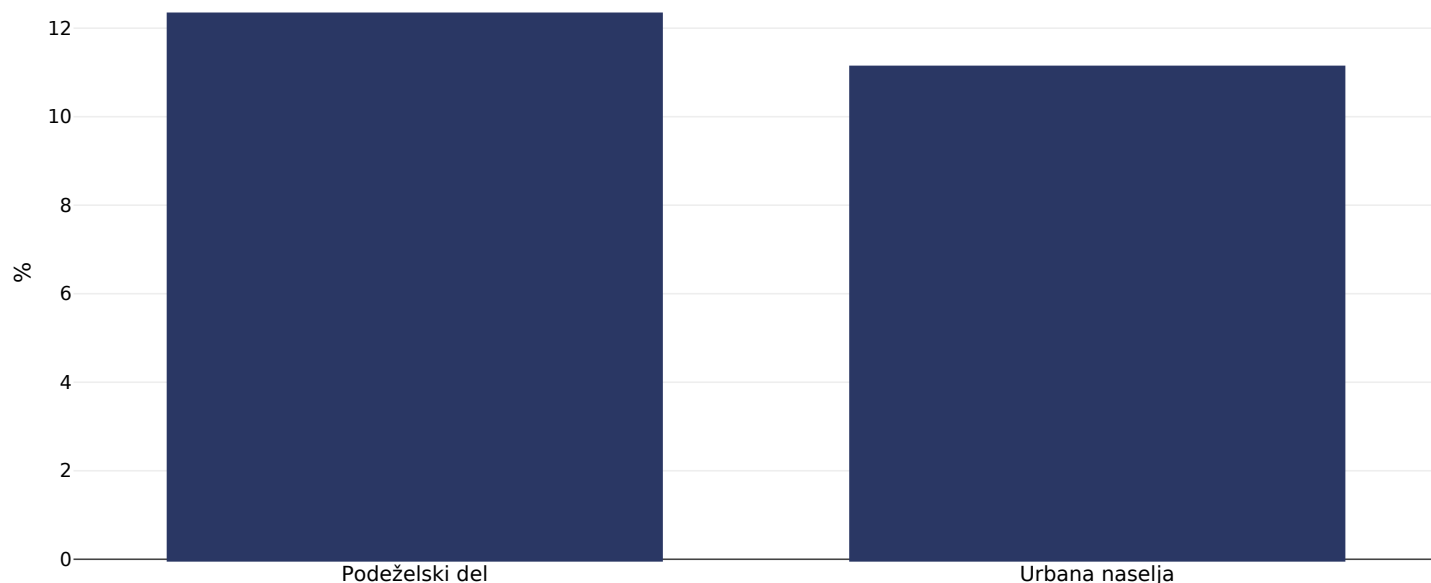

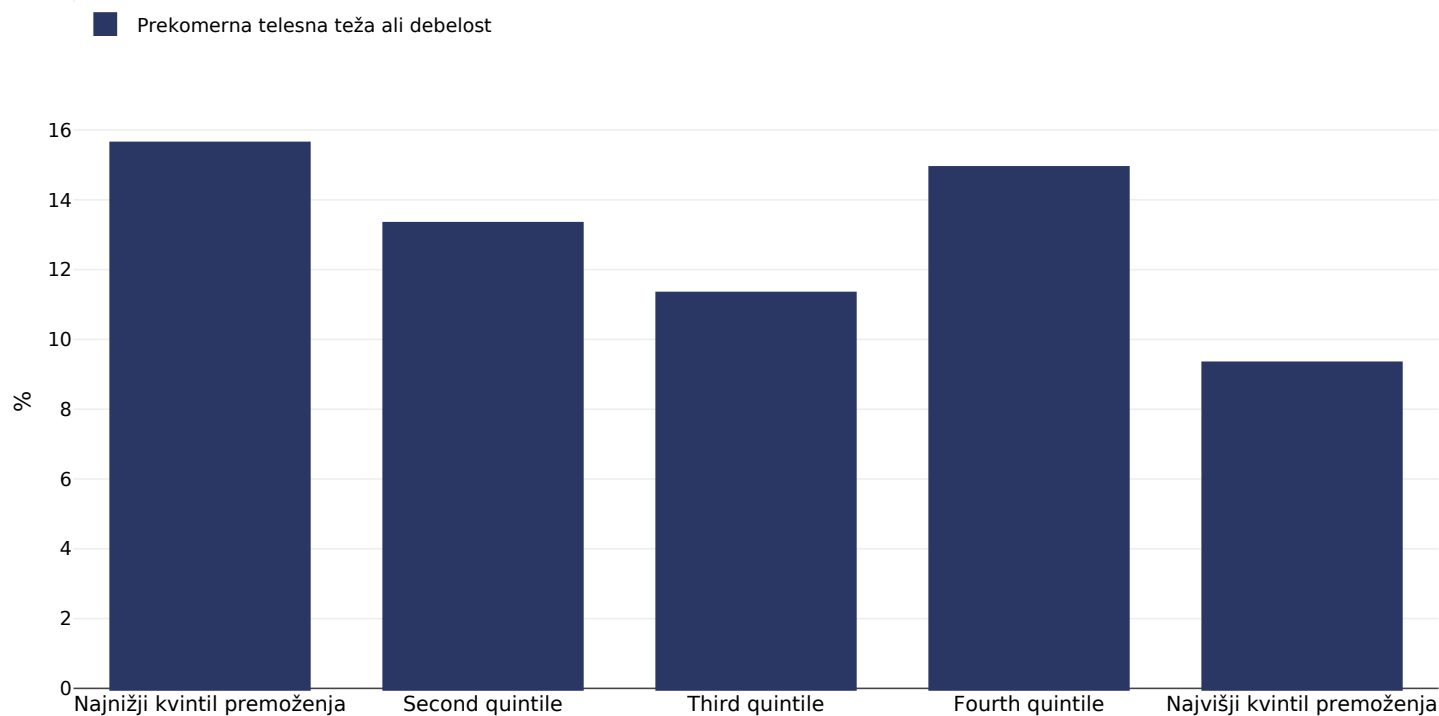

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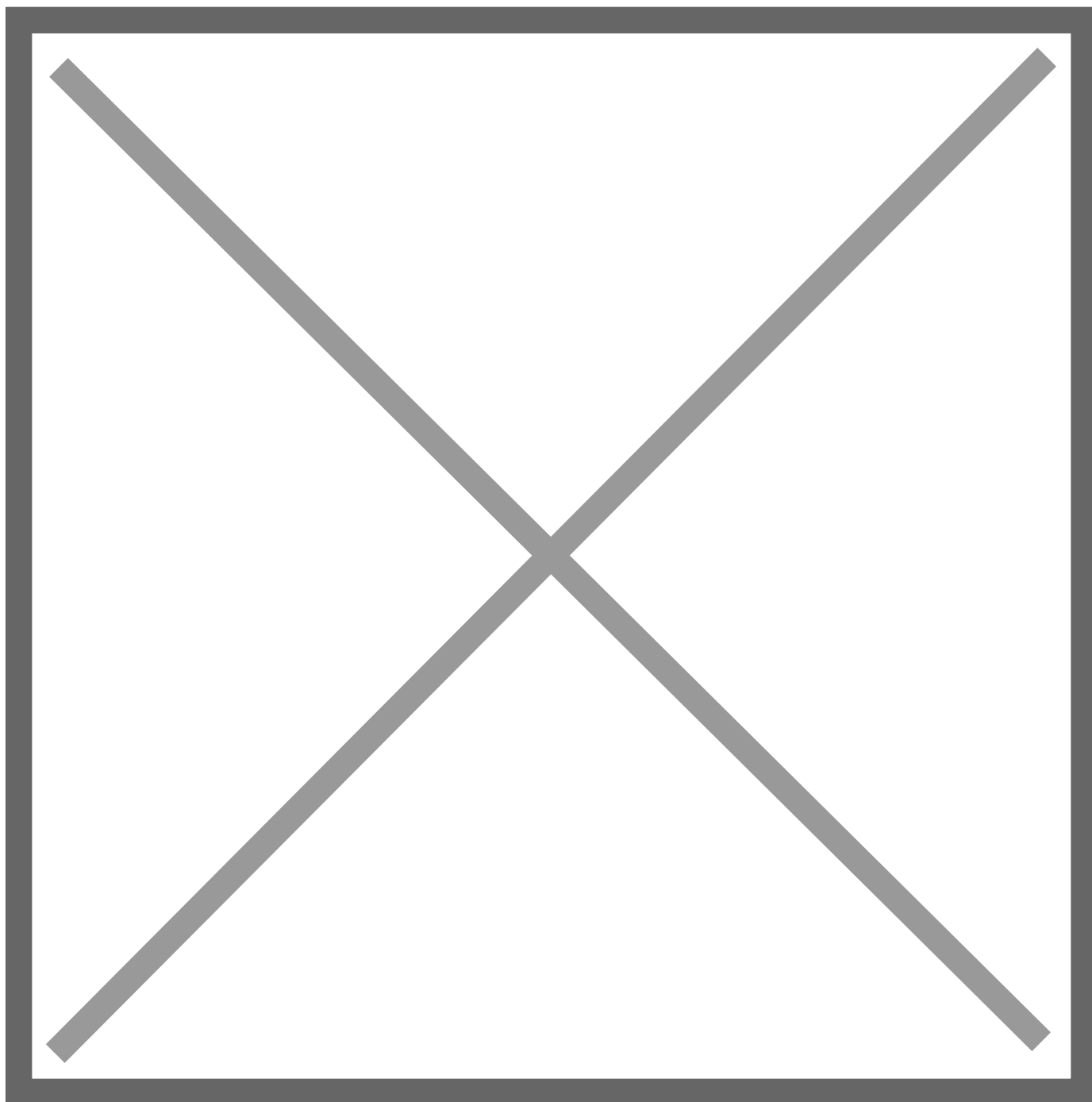

0-5 years, 2017-2017

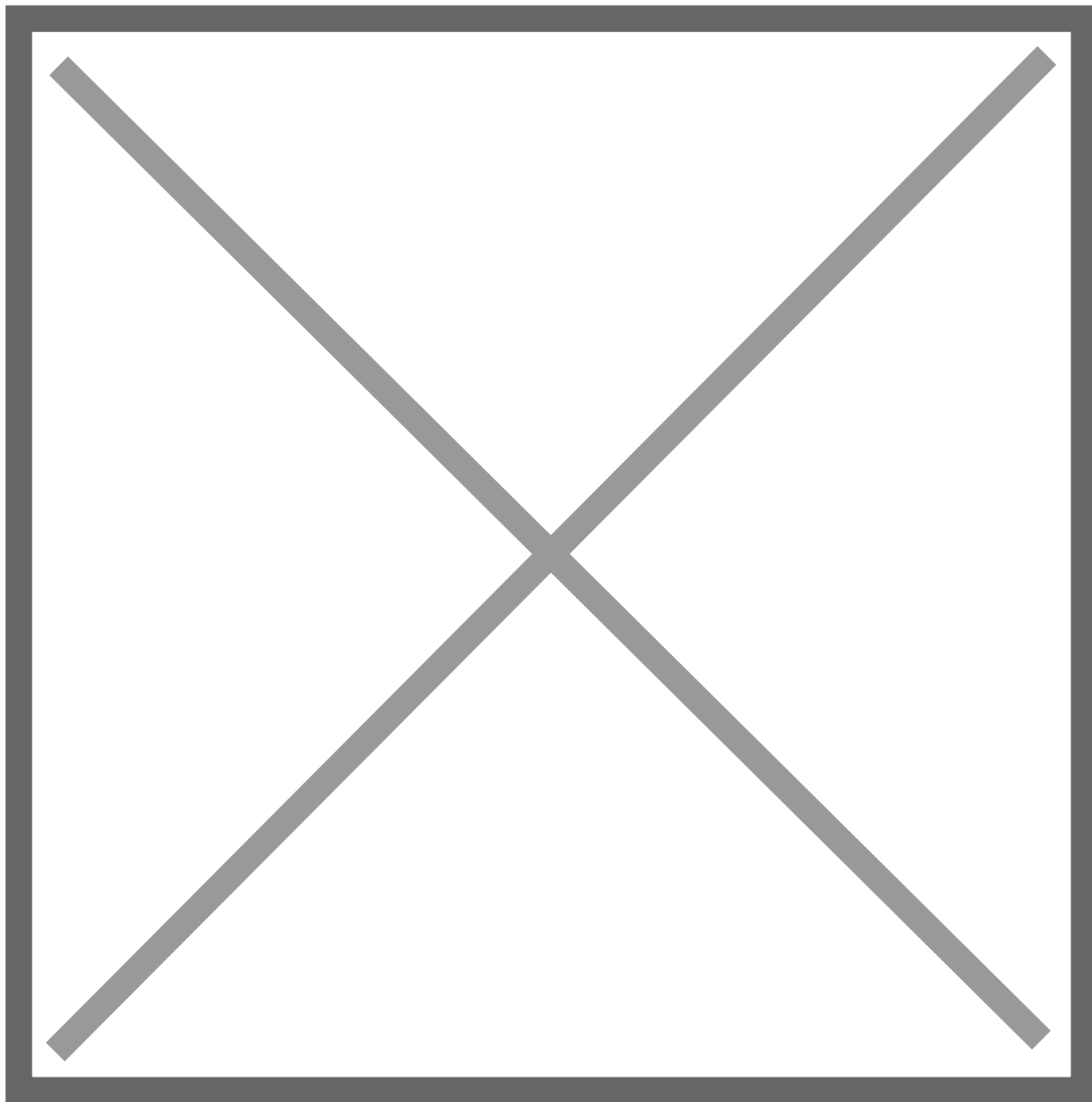
