

<b>Definitioner (kun tilgængelig på engelsk):</b>	According to the Asian-specific cut-off points, overweight was defined as a BMI from 23 kg/m <sup>2</sup> to less than 25 kg/m <sup>2</sup> , and general obesity was defined as a BMI of 25 kg/m <sup>2</sup> or greater for both men and women.
Medmindre andet er angivet, henviser overvægt til en BMI på mellem 25 kg og 29,9 kg/m <sup>2</sup> , fedme henviser til en BMI på mere end 30 kg/m <sup>2</sup> .
