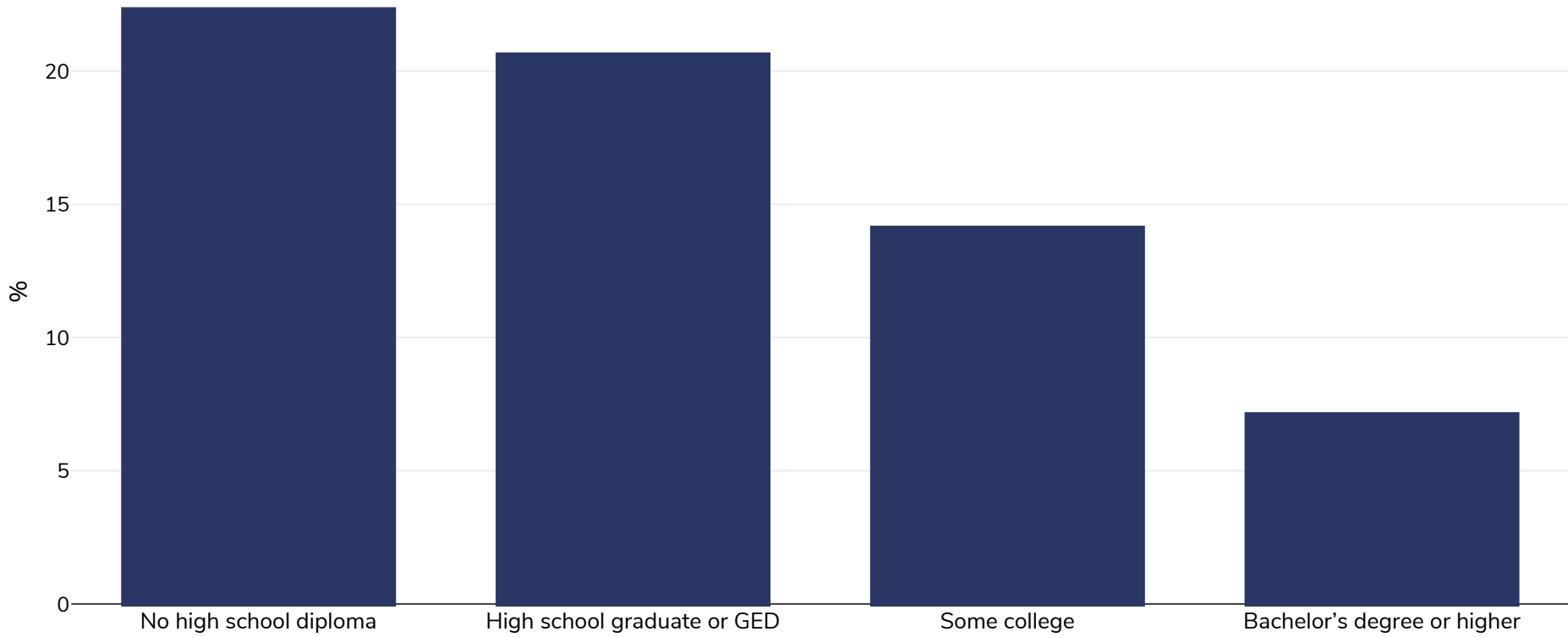


United States: Overweight/obesity by education
