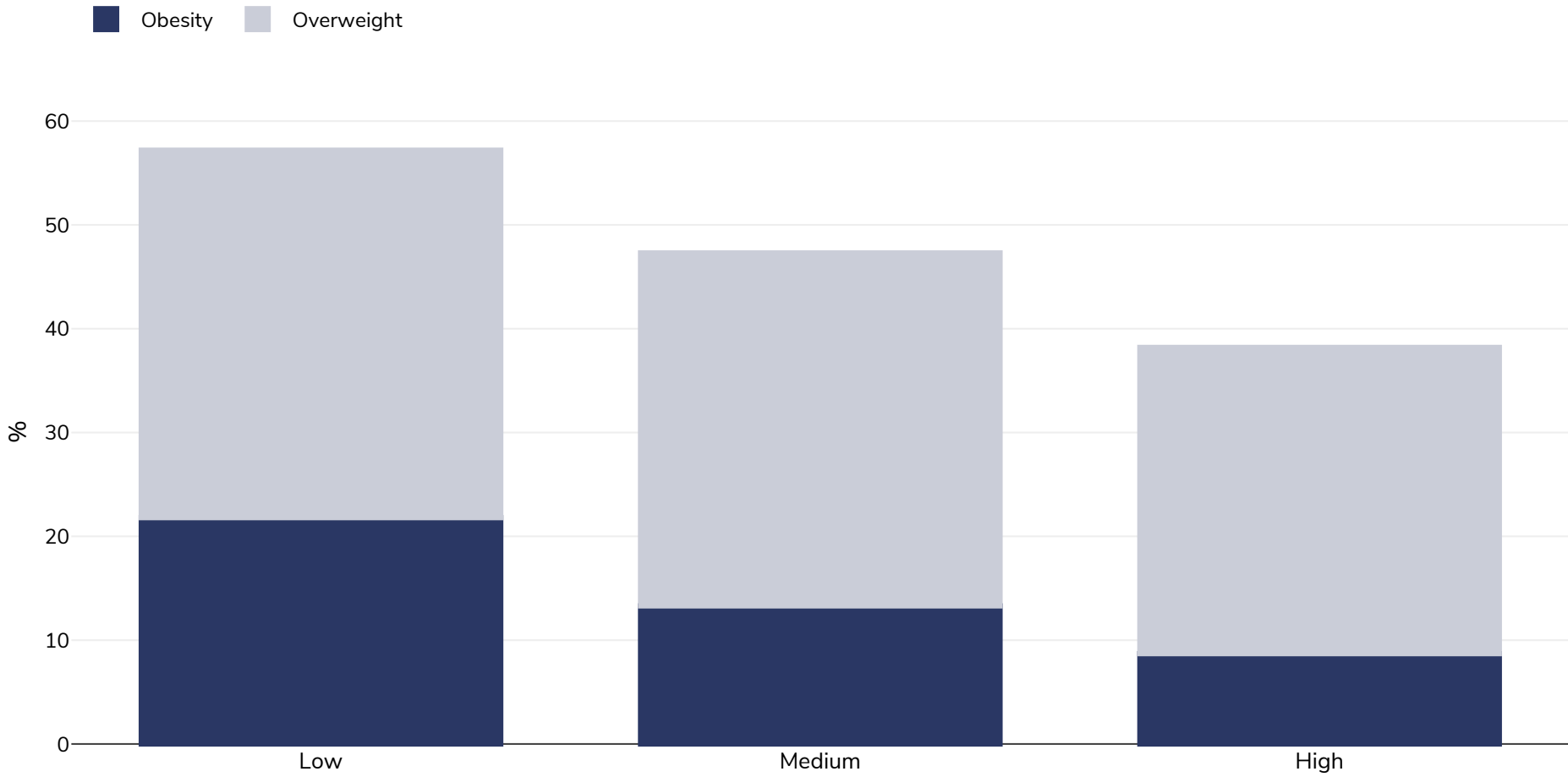


# Argentina: Overweight/obesity by socio-economic group

<b>Notes:</b>	Socio-economic status (SES) was built as a composite indicator following the Argentine Marketing Association's guidelines, which include four domains: educational level, job, housing, and amenities.  Unless otherwise noted, overweight refers to a BMI between 25kg and 29.9kg/m <sup>2</sup> , obesity refers to a BMI greater than 30kg/m <sup>2</sup> .
