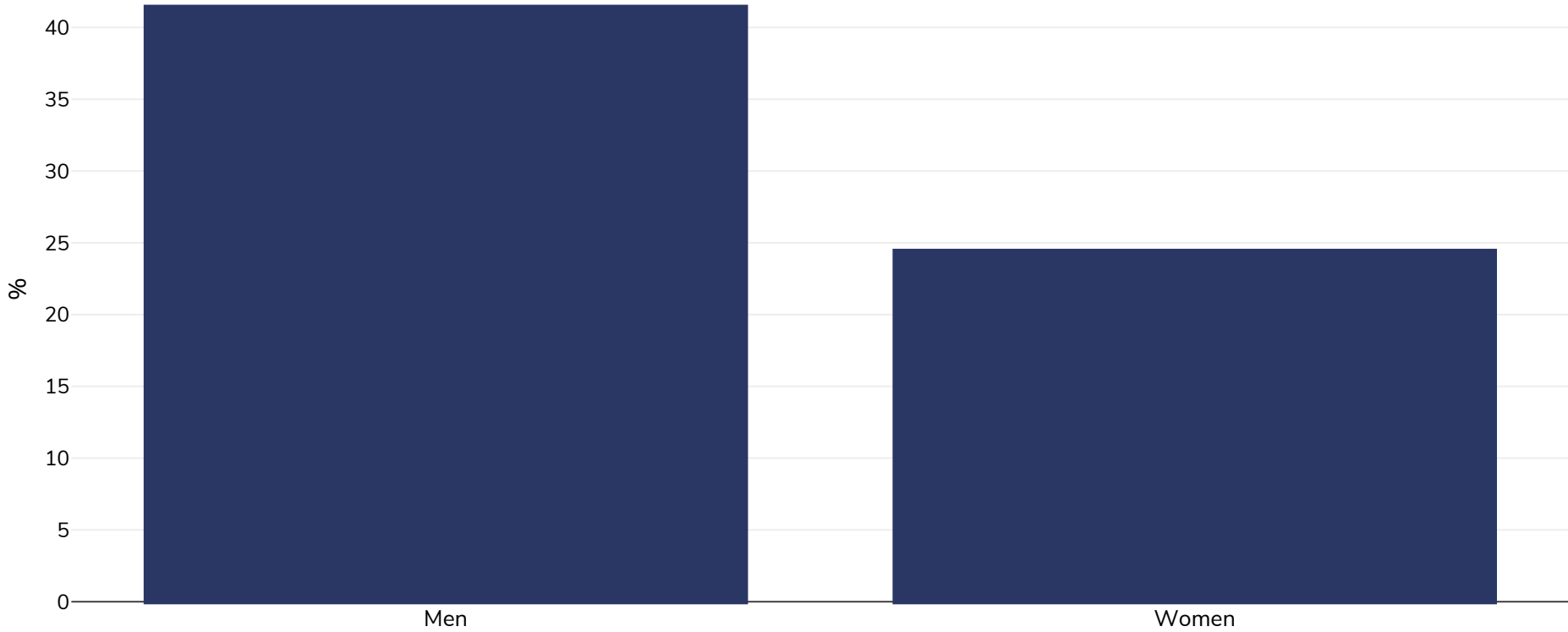

Notes: In paper Obesity was defined as a BMI of $\geq 25 \text{kg/m}^2$, according to the criteria of Asia-Pacific region. These % relate to the BMI definitions below Overweight BMI $\Rightarrow 25 \text{kg/m}^2$

Unless otherwise noted, overweight refers to a BMI between 25kg and 29.9kg/m², obesity refers to a BMI greater than 30kg/m².
