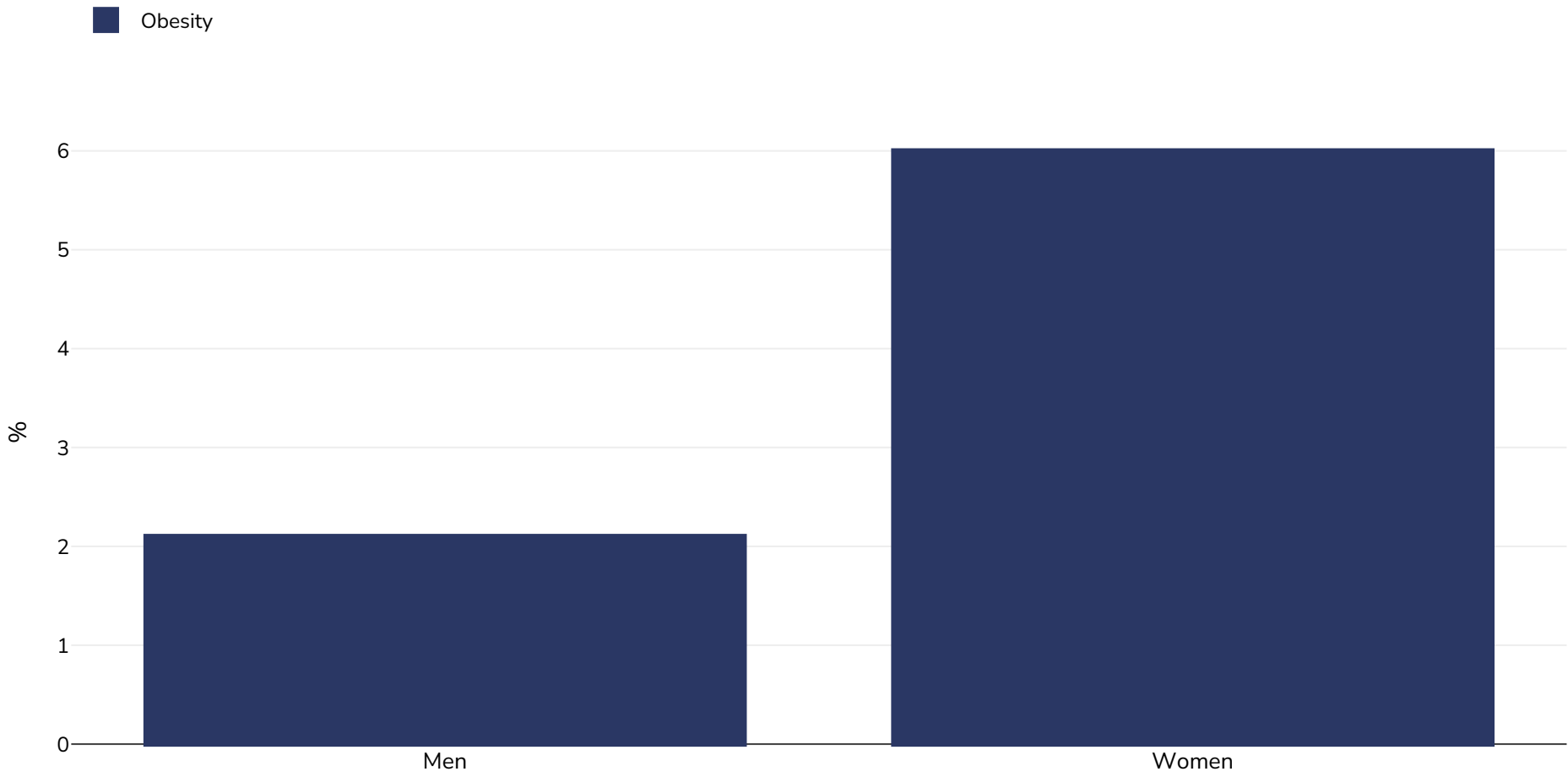


# Brazil: Obesity prevalence
