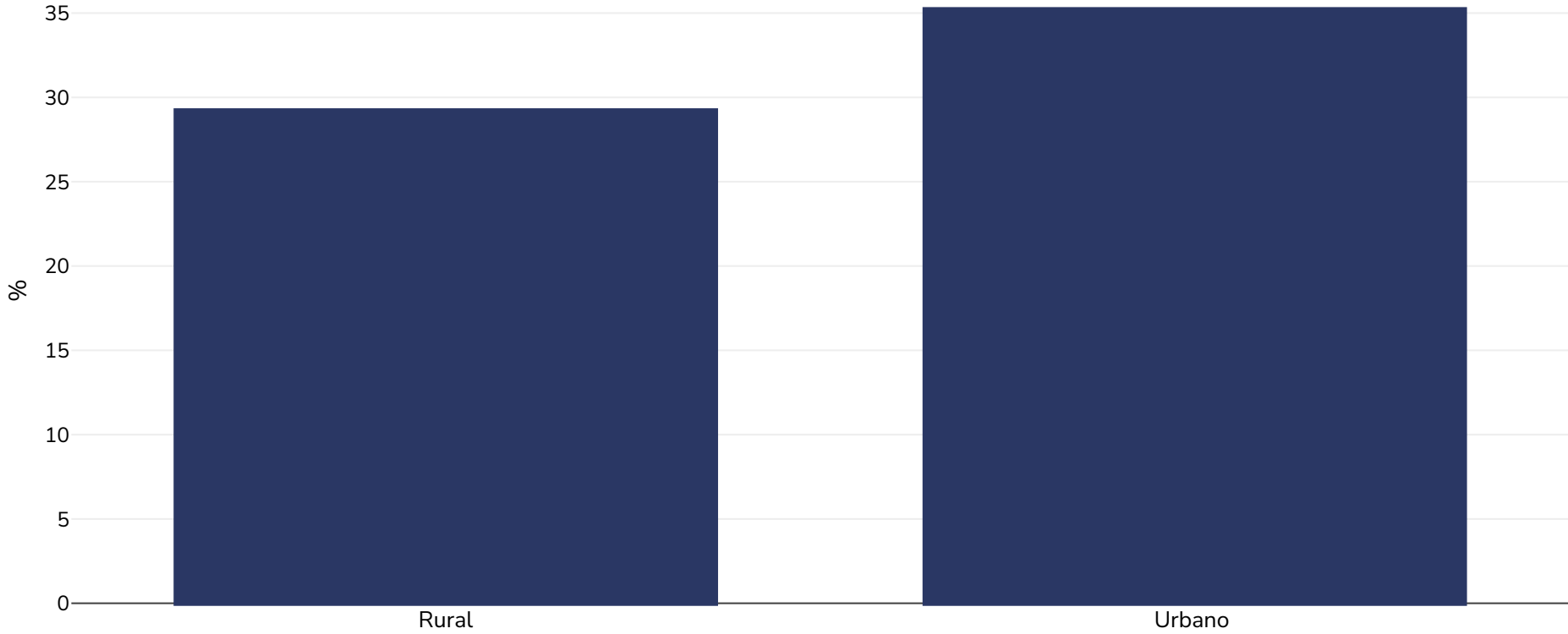

<b>Definiciones (solo disponible en inglés):</b>	According to the Asian-specific cut-off points, overweight was defined as a BMI from 23 kg/m <sup>2</sup> to less than 25 kg/m <sup>2</sup> , and general obesity was defined as a BMI of 25 kg/m <sup>2</sup> or greater for both men and women.

A menos que se indique lo contrario, el sobrepeso se refiere a un IMC entre 25 kg y 29,9 kg/m<sup>2</sup> y la obesidad se refiere a un IMC superior a 30 kg/m<sup>2</sup>.
