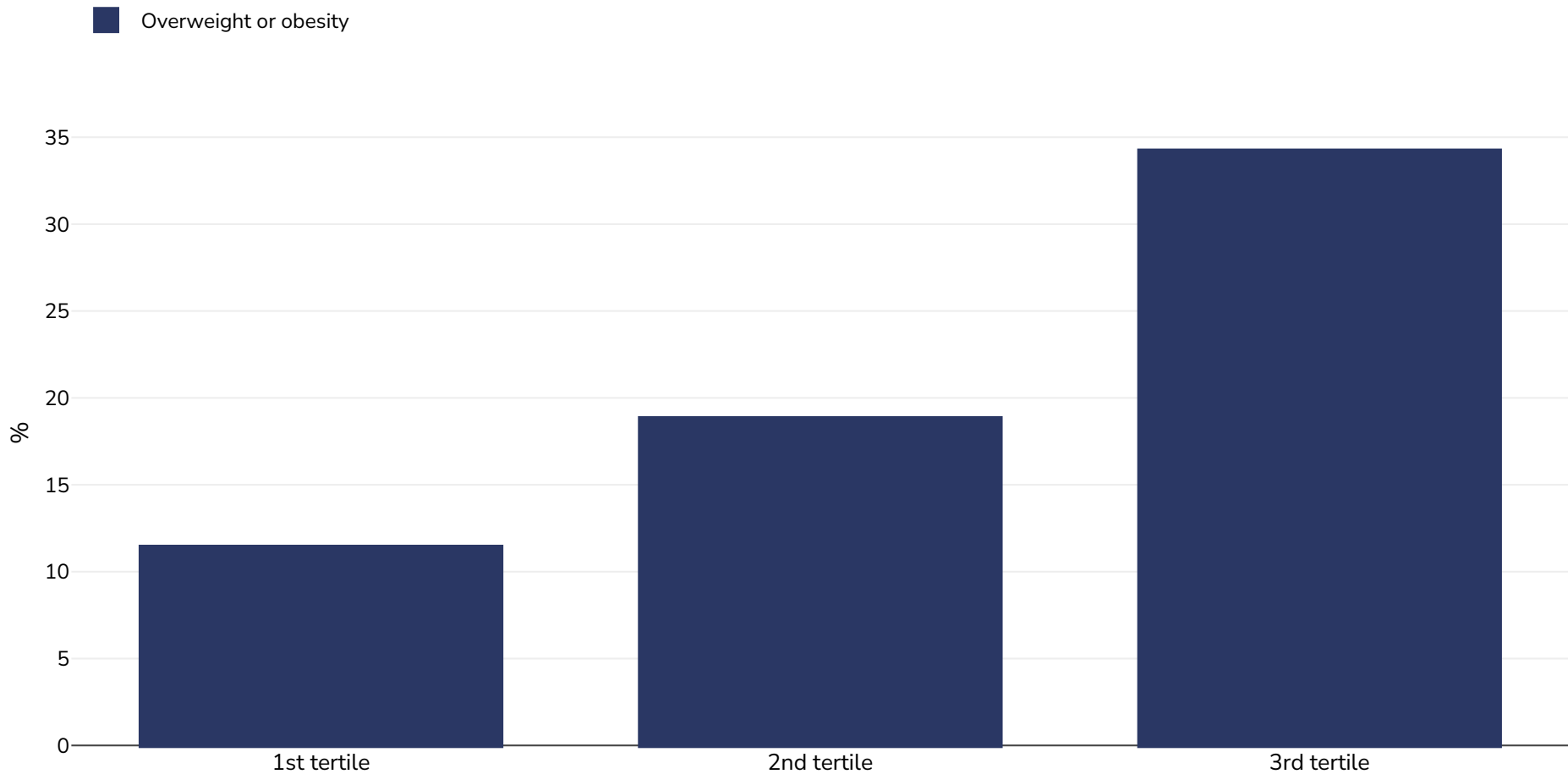

<b>Notes:</b>	Prevalence of overweight and obesity by income. Generalized obesity (GO) was defined as a BMI $\geq 25$ kg/m <sup>2</sup> for both genders (based on the World Health Organization Asia Pacific Guidelines).

Unless otherwise noted, overweight refers to a BMI between 25kg and 29.9kg/m<sup>2</sup>, obesity refers to a BMI greater than 30kg/m<sup>2</sup>.
