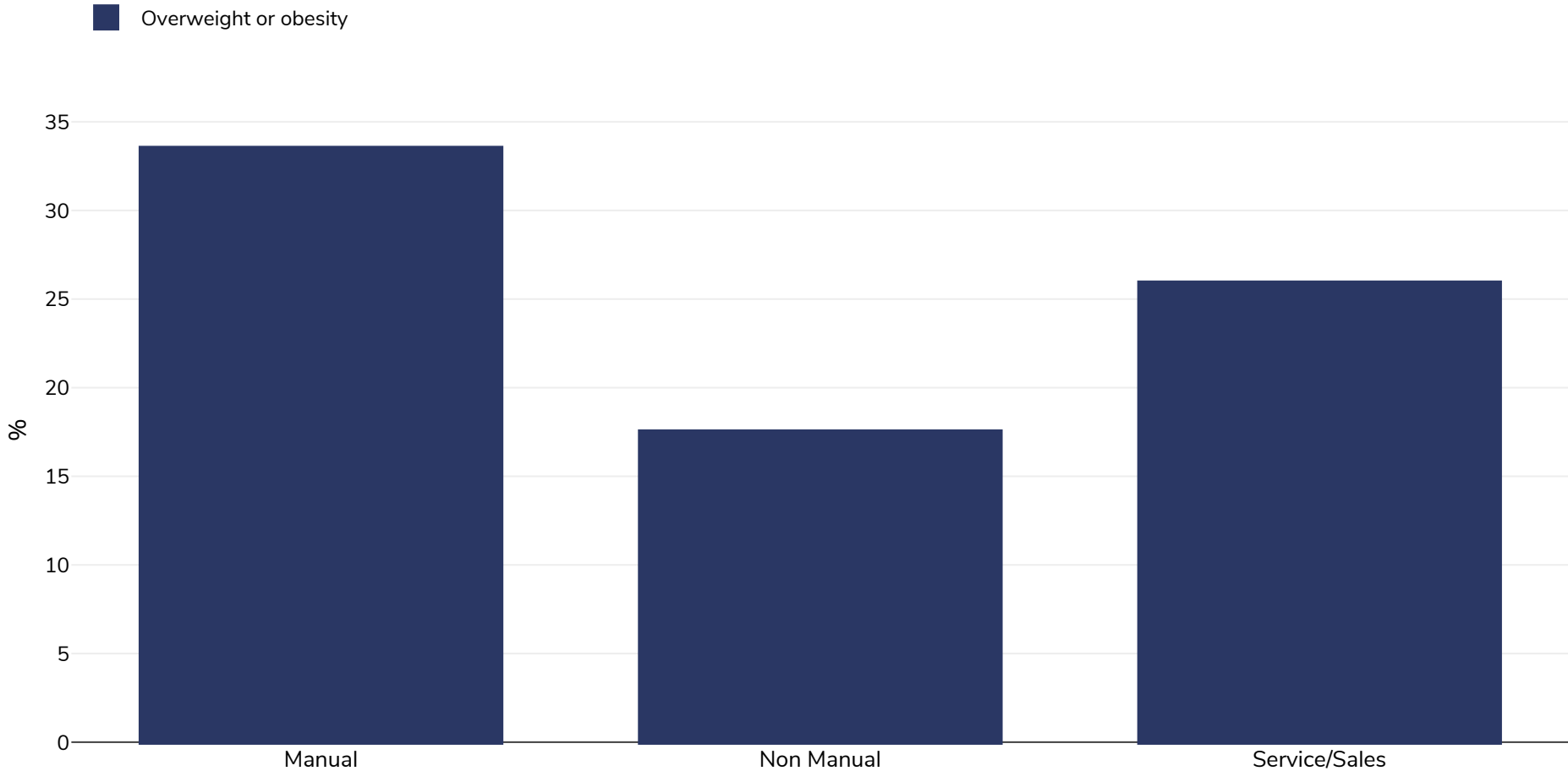


# South Korea: Overweight/obesity by socio-economic group
