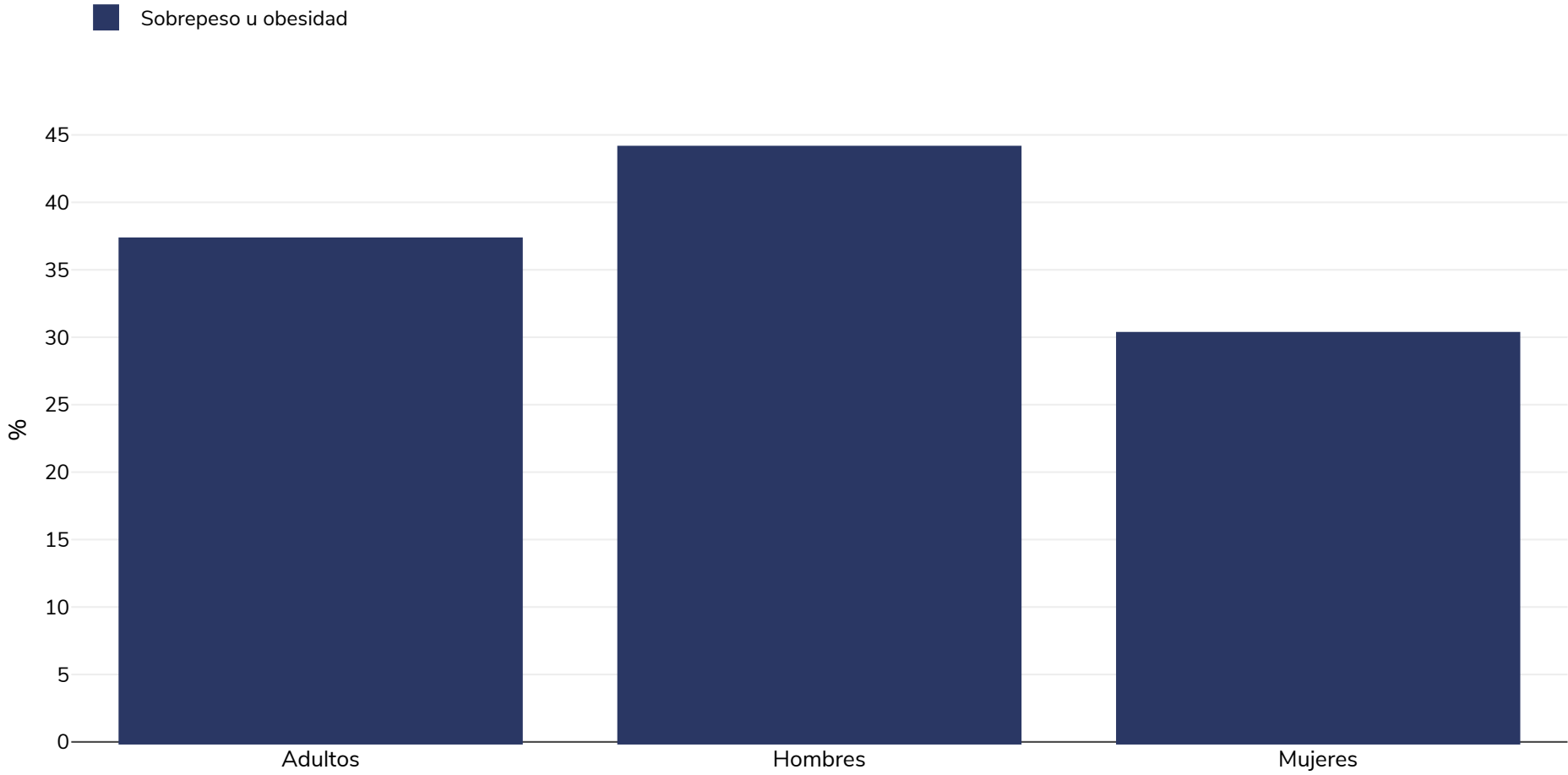

Definiciones (solo disponible en inglés):	According to the Asian-specific cut-off points, overweight was defined as a BMI from 23 kg/m ² to less than 25 kg/m ² , and general obesity was defined as a BMI of 25 kg/m ² or greater for both men and women. Data by age and by region using Asian-specific cut-off points are also available in the paper.
Cutoffs:	WHO Asia
