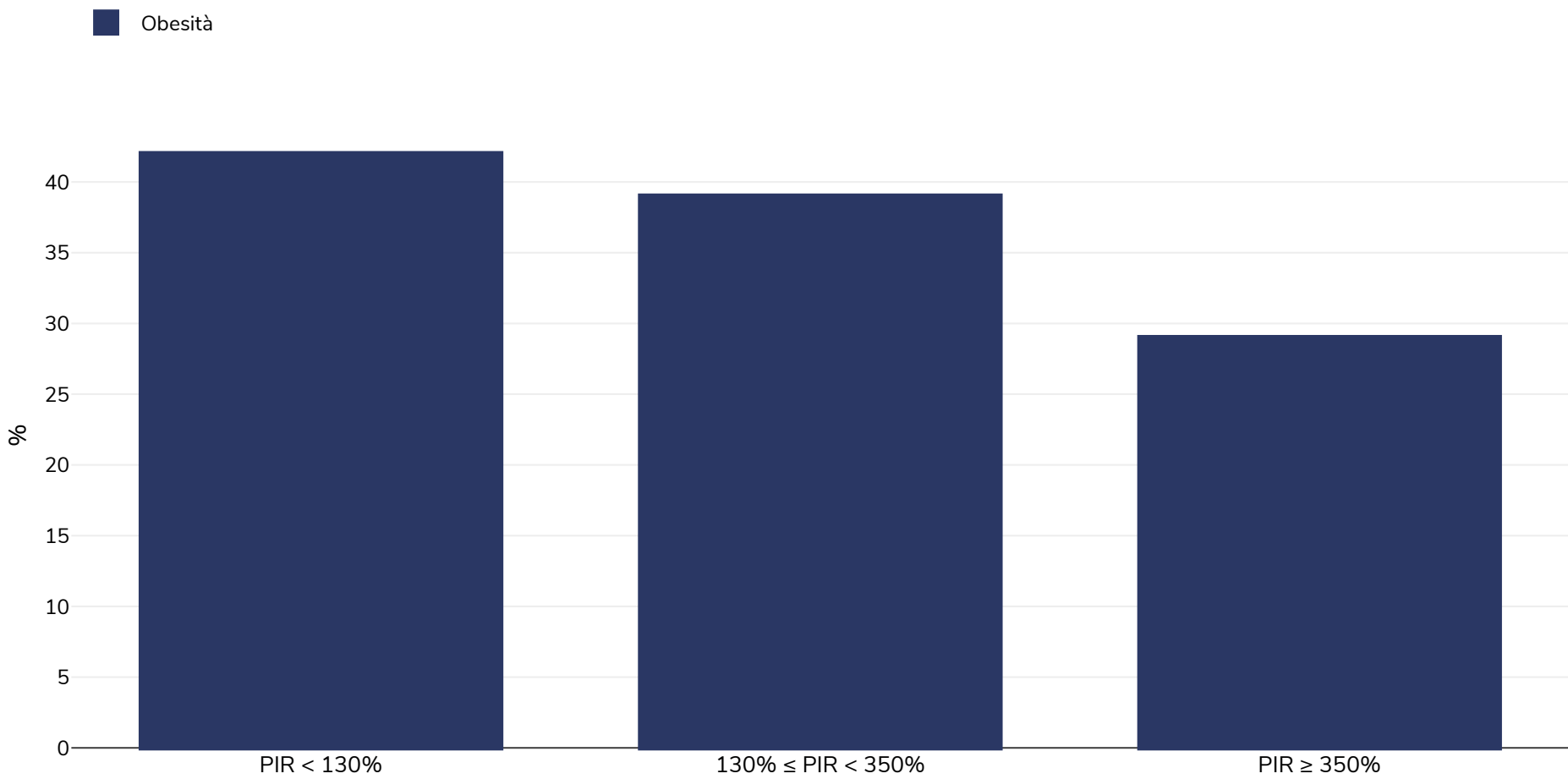

**Note (disponibile solo in inglese):** Poverty income ratio (PIR): The ratio of household income to the poverty threshold after accounting for inflation and family size. In 2008, a PIR of 350% was equivalent to approximately \$77,000 for a family of four; a PIR of 130% was equivalent to approximately \$29,000 for a family of four.

Salvo diversa indicazione, il sovrappeso si riferisce a un BMI compreso tra 25 kg e 29,9 kg/m<sup>2</sup>, l'obesità si riferisce a un BMI superiore a 30 kg/m<sup>2</sup>.
