

Notas:

Poverty income ratio (PIR): The ratio of household income to the poverty threshold after accounting for inflation and family size. In 2008, a PIR of 350% was equivalent to approximately \$77,000 for a family of four; a PIR of 130% was equivalent to approximately \$29,000 for a family of four.

A menos que se indique lo contrario, el sobrepeso se refiere a un IMC entre 25 kg/m<sup>2</sup> y 29,9 kg/m<sup>2</sup> y la obesidad se refiere a un IMC superior a 30 kg/m<sup>2</sup>.
