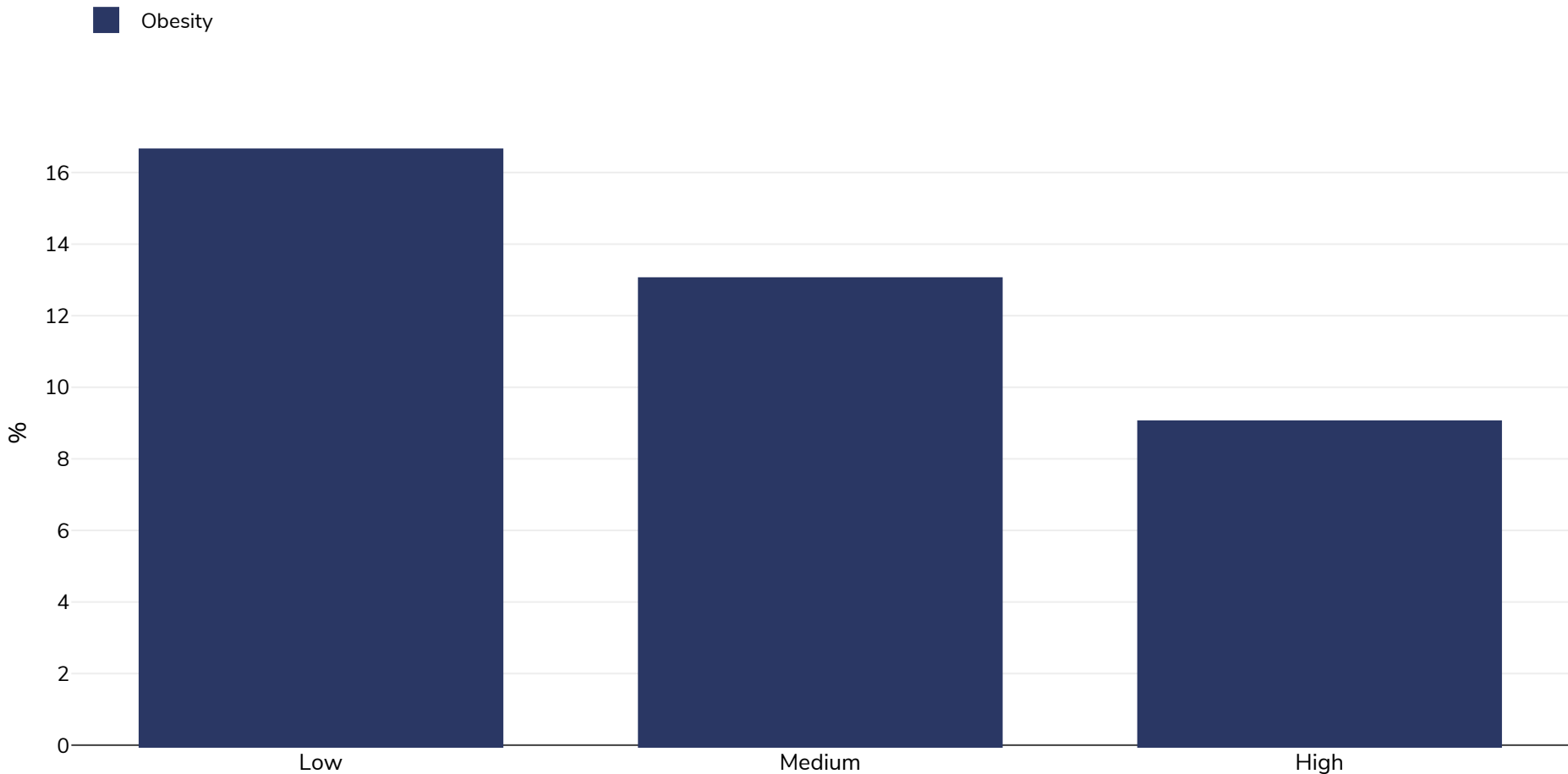


# Spain: Overweight/obesity by education
