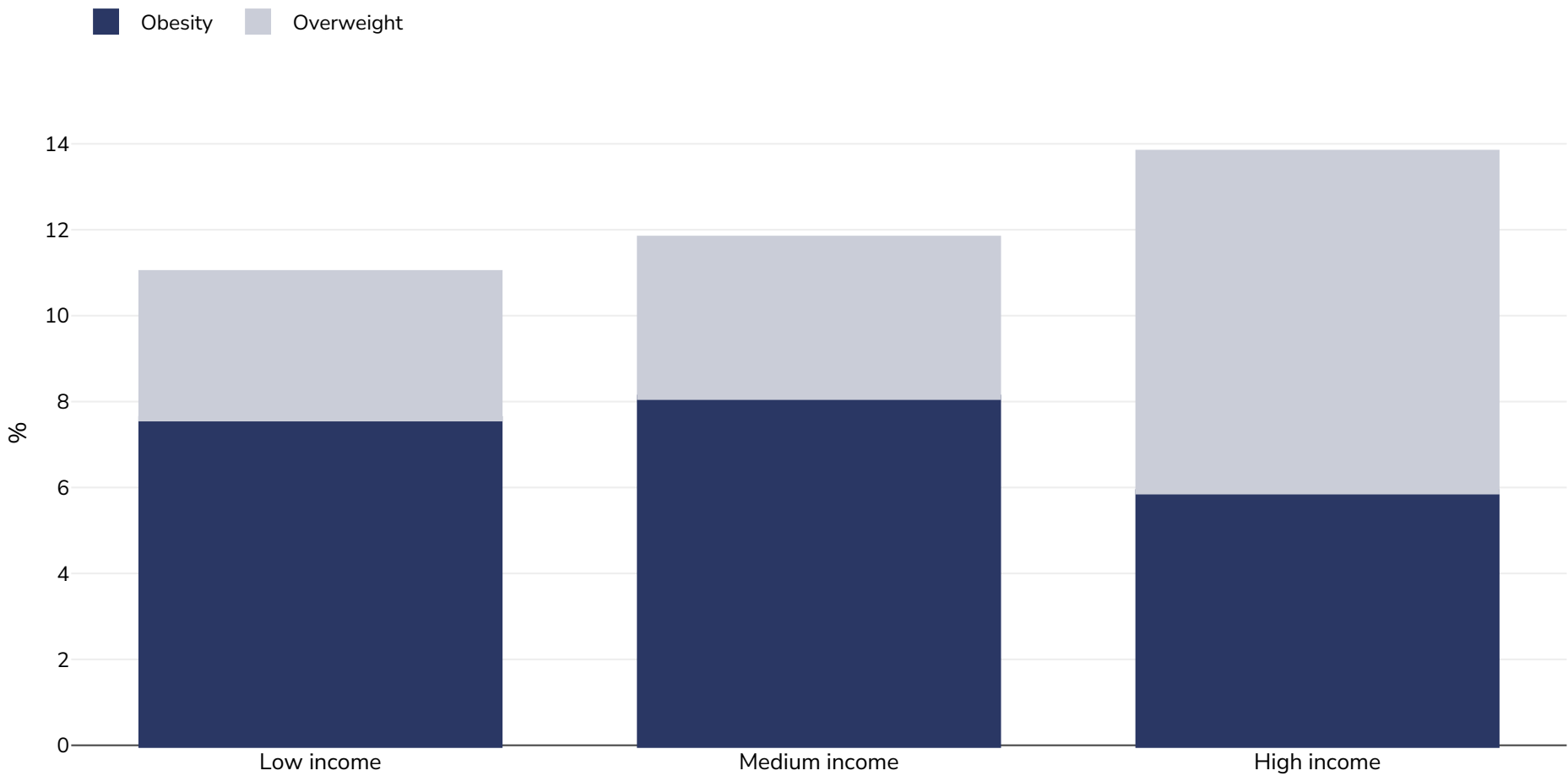


# China: Overweight/obesity by socio-economic group

Age:	6-9
Sample size:	Total sample size (6-18yrs old) = 3028
Area covered:	The China Health and Nutrition Surveys (CHNS) covered eight provinces that vary substantially in geography, economic development, public resources, and health indicators.
