
United States: Overweight/obesity by socio-economic group

Poverty income ratio (PIR): The ratio of household income to the poverty threshold after accounting for inflation and family size. In 2008, a PIR of 350% was equivalent to approximately \$77,000 for a family of four; a PIR of 130% was equivalent to approximately \$29,000 for a family of four.

Unless otherwise noted, overweight refers to a BMI between 25kg and 29.9kg/m², obesity refers to a BMI greater than 30kg/m².
